East Aberdeen Waterfront Walkway

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The East Aberdeen Waterfront Walkway is a 6-foot wide asphalt trail that meanders along the north side of the Chehalis River in Aberdeen. Historically, this land was used for industrial purposes, and the riverfront walk still has views of the former site of the Weyerhaeuser Sawmill on the south side of the river.

The trail runs through Aberdeen's popular Morrison Riverfront Park, home to a log pavilion, picnic tables and a fishing and viewing dock. The trail also provides safe and direct access to a number of retail establishments on US 12.

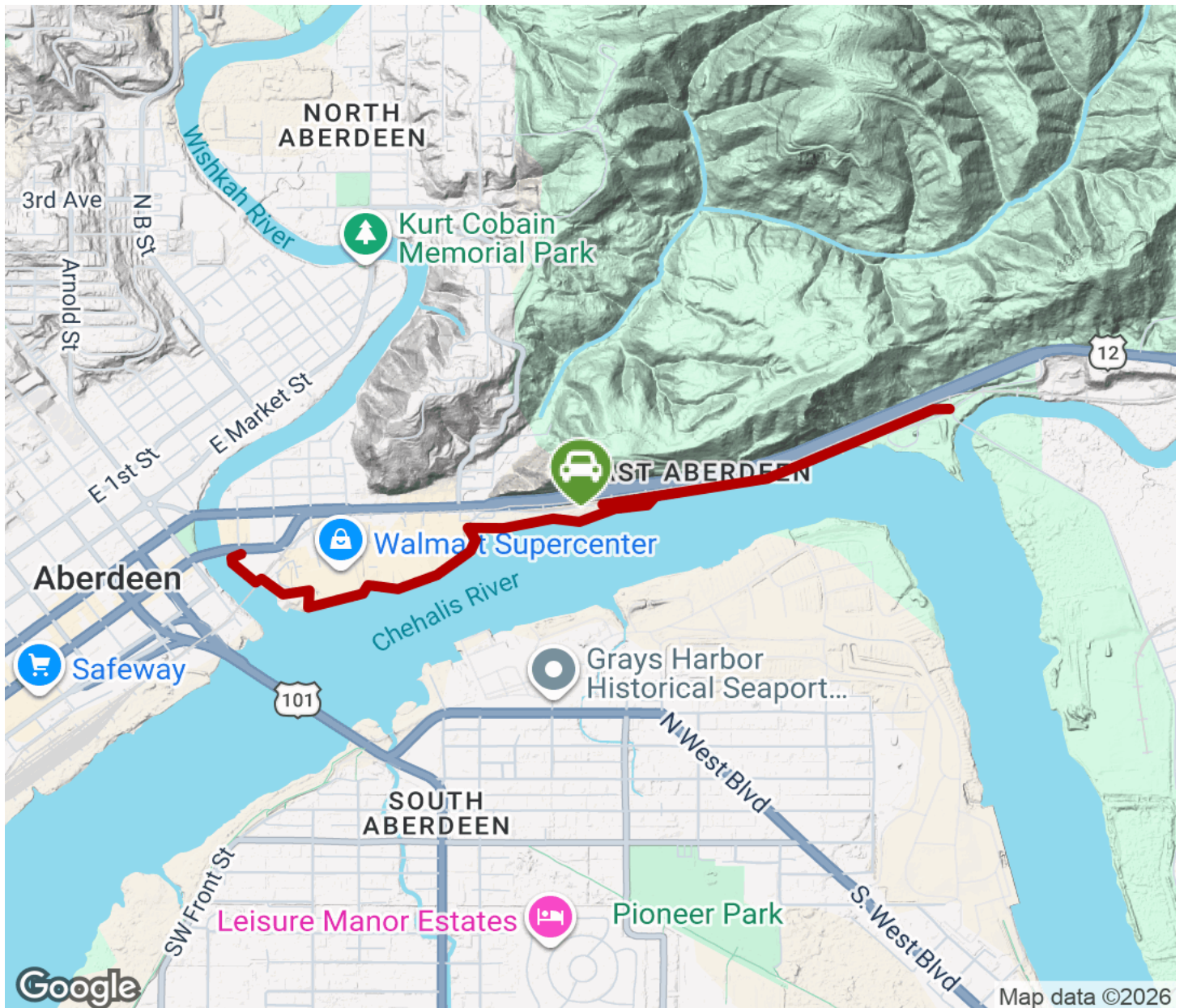
Parking & Trail Access
