There is no parking set aside for trail use. Parking is available on local side streets in the area or at the Metro-North train station parking lot.



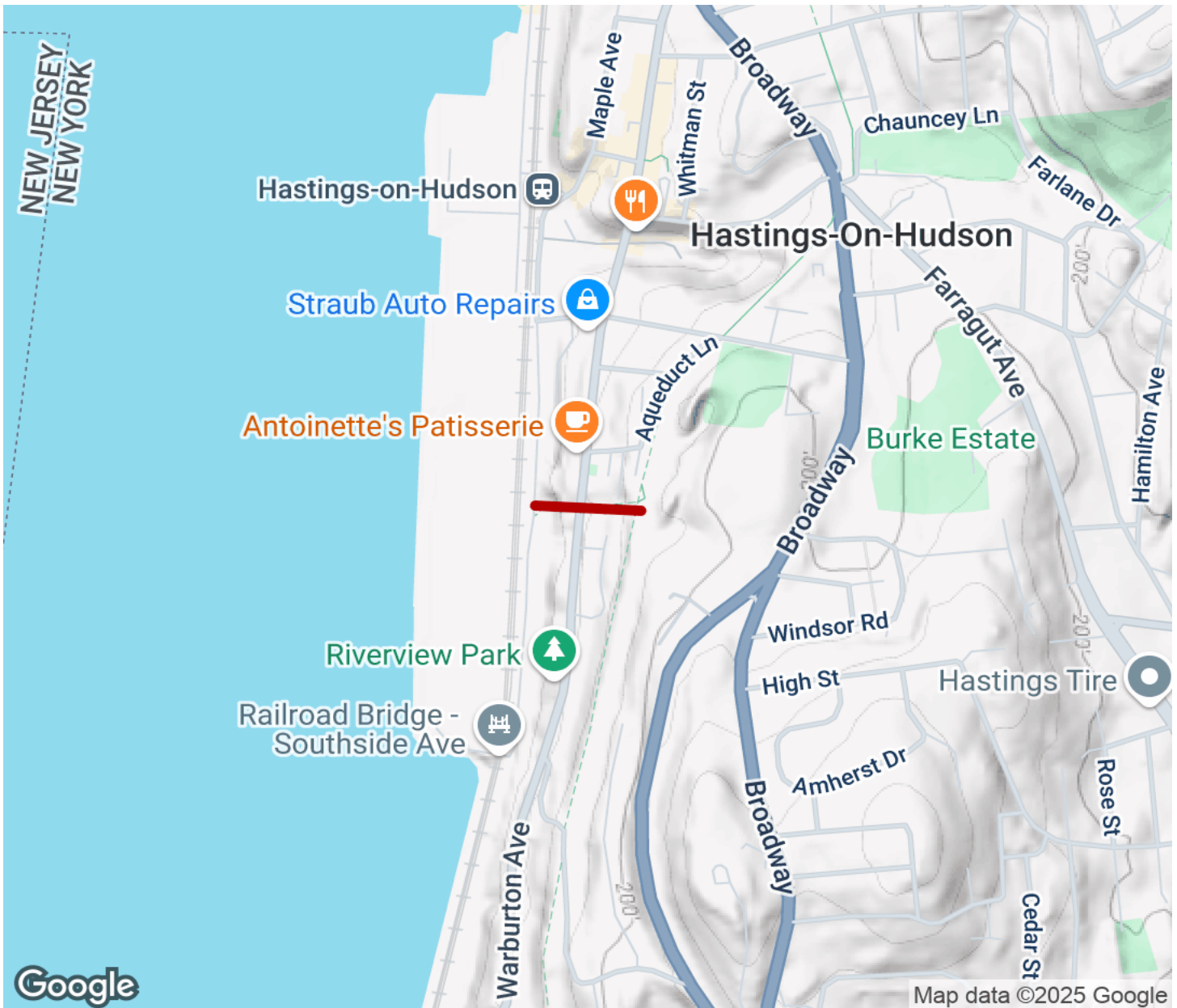
