The trails form a network of more than 40 miles for non-motorized uses, linking neighborhoods, business districts, shopping, and 21 parks. You can also visit the Botanic Garden and Japanese Garden, Log Cabin Village, the zoo, the historic Stockyards, and downtown Fort Worth.
