The Venetian Waterway Park Trail follows along both sides of the Intracoastal Waterway for 9.2 miles, from the ocean north and



the [Legacy Trail](#) which continues toward Sarasota.

The Venetian Waterway Park Trail follows along both sides of the Intracoastal Waterway for 9.2 miles, from the ocean north and somewhat east, past the Venice Airport to north of Venice Avenue.

About the Route

The Venetian Waterway Park Trail is flat and often windy, passing through a mix of urban corridor and open green space. Colorful murals, covered rest and picnic areas, and interpretive signs dot the way. There are also playgrounds, fitness stops, and parks.

- Casperson Beach Playground (Venice)

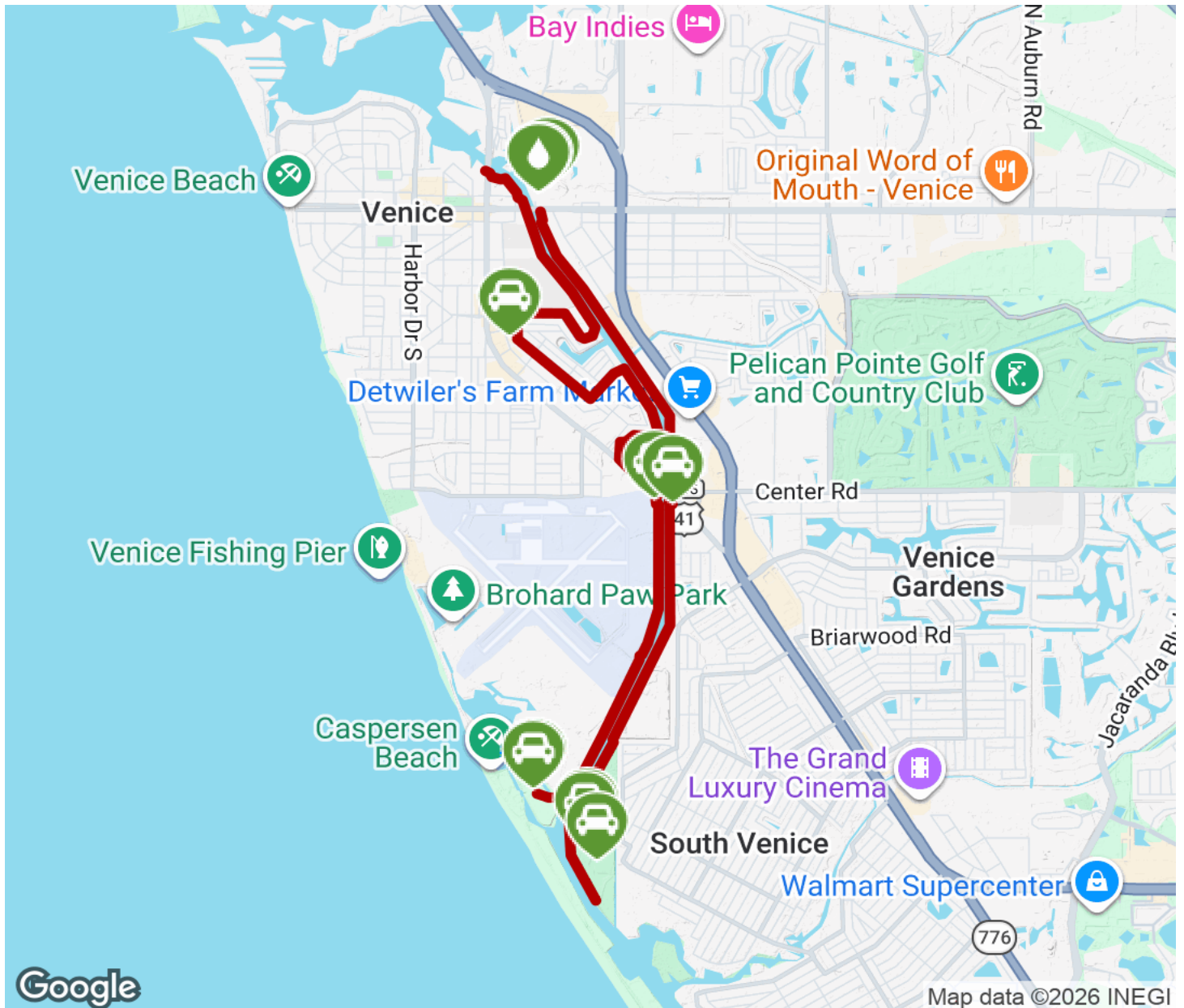
The Sarasota County Transit system (SCAT) provides access to the trail via bus.
