Overview

Running along the former line of the Orange Belt Railway, the Seminole-Wekiva Trail offers a peaceful alternative to the busy streets of Altamonte Springs. This popular, well-marked, 20-mile route is one of Seminole County's showcase trails, with an additional 6.5 miles in neighboring Lake County known as the Wekiva Trail.

Wekiva Trail (Lake County)

The Wekiva Trail in Lake County runs for 6.5 miles, paralleling SR 46 to Wekiva River Road. As it heads east from Sorrento Ave. the trail reaches its easternmost trail end at the Lake/Seminole County Line where it crosses the Wekiva River. The trail ends in name here but

continues seamlessly from here as the Seminole Wekiva Trail.

Seminole Wekiva County

After crossing the border of Lake/Seminole County along the Wekiva River, the trail continues east through a peaceful, wooded landscape. Exiting this peaceful wooded environment, the trail then turns south and begins the rail-trail portion of the route.

As the trail begins south, the quiet wooded landscape turns into a suburban landscape as it skirts along International Parkway, when retail and convenience options (as well as bathroom and water options for trail users).

About 9 miles from that cluster of retail options, the Seminole Wekiva Trail passes the Seminole County Softball Complex. The southernmost portion of the trail has a couple notable highlights including crossing the Little Wekiva River via. a wooden bridge and traverses through shaded Spanish moss before reaching the southernmost point of the trail on N Orange Blossom Trail (US-441).

Connections

The Wekiva Trail (Lake County) connects with the Neighborhood Lakes Scenic Trail.

Along the International Parkway, the trail intersects with the <u>Cross-Seminole Trail</u>.
