About the Route

The trail encompasses wooded areas, open meadows, and the quaint commercial village. In the center of downtown, the 10-foot wide, multi-use paved trail is fully handicap accessible and has many amenities.

In addition to fishing piers, canoe launches, observation areas, picnic facilities, and recreation spots, you'll find restaurants, coffee houses, and shops.

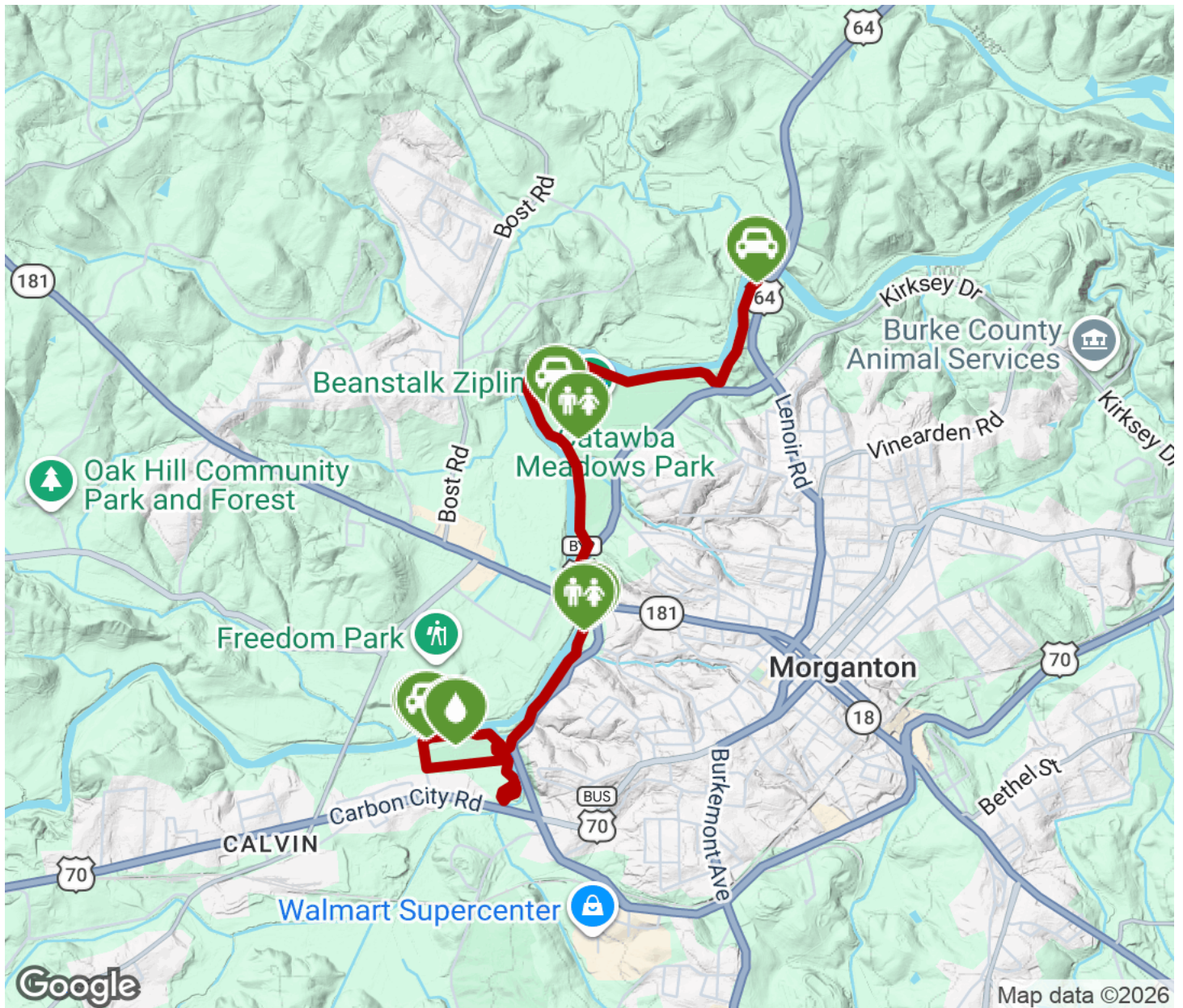
