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The Wildwood Crest Bike Path is a one-mile bike path that runs along the beach from East Cresse Avenue to East Rambler Road.



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About the Route

The trail connects trail users to the south end of the Wildwood Boardwalk as well as several parks including Scoop Taylor Park, Morey Field, Centennial Park and more. Situated in downtown Wildwood Crest, the trail provides an excellent off-road alternative.
