The White Rock Creek Trail is part of the city of Dallas's trail system. The trail travels 8.5 miles between W. Lawther Drive at Mockingbird near White Rock Lake Park north and Valley View Park on Hillcrest in North Dallas.

## About the Route

The White Rock Creek Trail generally follows White Rock Creek and passes through neighborhoods and several parks, including Valley View, Anderson Bonner, Orbiter, and Harry Moss.

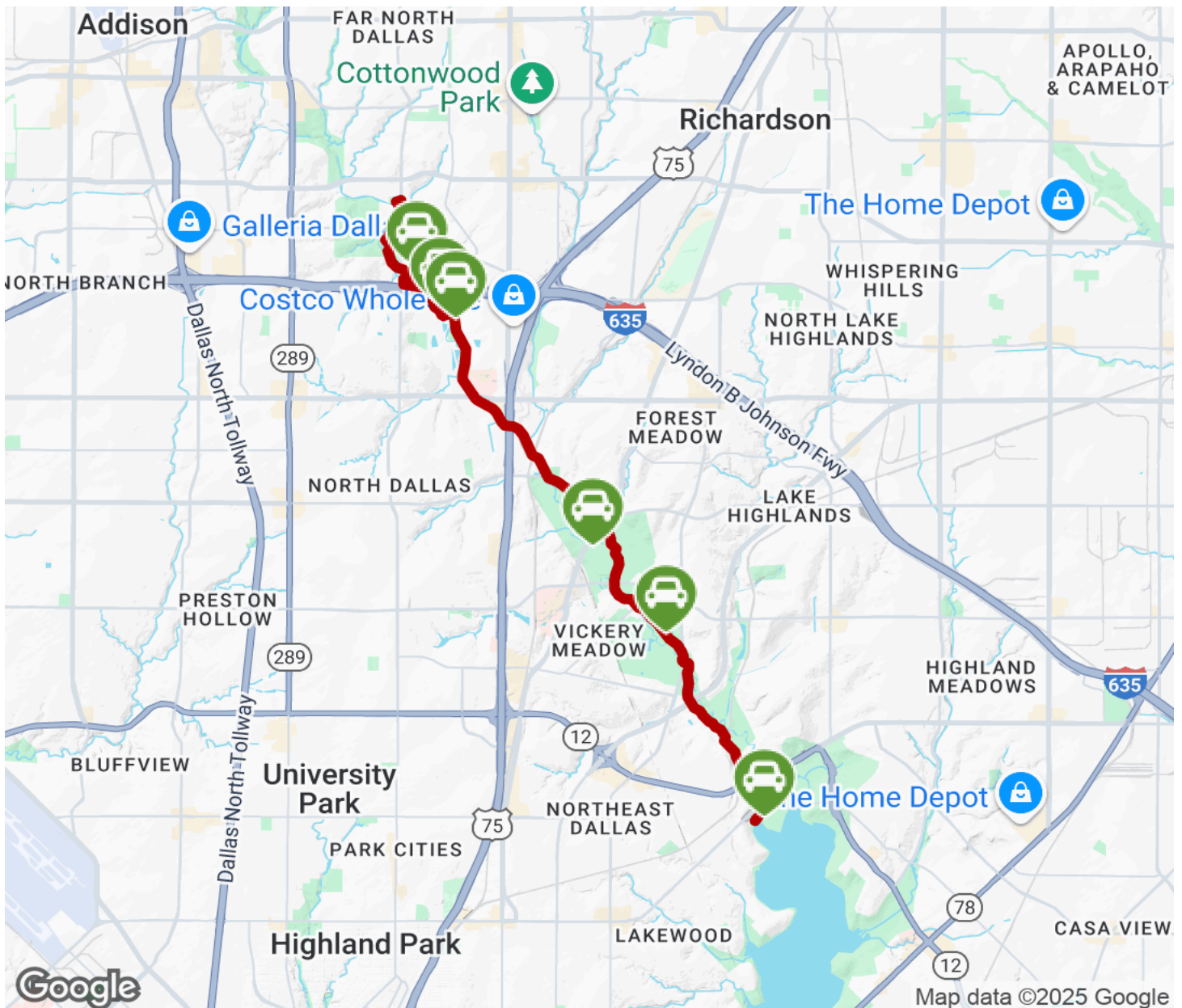
