The Little Econ Greenway trail is just one section of the Orlando area's many fine trails. The trail offers riverside recreation, picnicking, wildlife watching, and canoe trails. It also features a canal system that you can paddle along. Whether on land or water, you can watch for wildlife, including osprey, red-shouldered hawks, turtles and alligators. In addition, the butterfly garden along the trail is a delight.

The trail will eventually link to the University of Central Florida and continue north to the [Cross Seminole Trail](#) system through the city of Oviedo and back to Blanchard Park. There are also plans to extend the western terminus of the Little Econ Greenway to the [Cady Way Trail](#) at Lake Baldwin.
