The Little Econ Greenway offers riverside recreation, picnicking, wildlife watching, and canoe trails. It also features a canal system that trail users can paddle along. Whether on land or water, trail users should watch for wildlife, including osprey, red-shouldered hawks, turtles, and alligators. In addition, the butterfly garden along the trail is a delight.



