The Gresham Fairview Trail is a north-south corridor that will one day link Portland's 40-Mile Loop Trail (<u>Marine</u> <u>Drive section</u>) with the <u>Springwater Trail</u>'s section through Gresham. As of spring 2012, the trail runs for a little more than 3 miles between the Springwater Trail and NE Halsey Street in Gresham. Plans are underway to finish the remaining 2 miles north to Marine Drive in Portland.

The Gresham Fairview Trail will also provide access to nature areas along Johnson Creek, Fairview Creek, Columbia Slough and the Columbia River.


Parking & Trail Access
