The Springfield Branch Trail was built on a former railroad corridor and travels east-west for 1.4 miles in Delaware, Ohio. The paved trail is friendly to walkers, bikers and roller bladers. The trail begins at Winter Street and US 42 and heads west, crossing over the Oletangy River and Columbus Pike/ US 23. The trail provides connections to schools, retail shopping and recreation areas, like parks. It also intersects with the Oletangy Trail at Henry Street.
