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The Northern Tier Trail winds through East Lansing on the outskirts of Michigan's capital, offering miles of paved pathway through tree-lined areas and wetlands. The 10-foot-wide trail connects several community parks, recreational facilities and neighborhoods. Not far west of the trail, trail users will enjoy shops and restaurants off Lake Lansing Road, and the trail is only about a mile north of downtown and the Michigan State University campus.

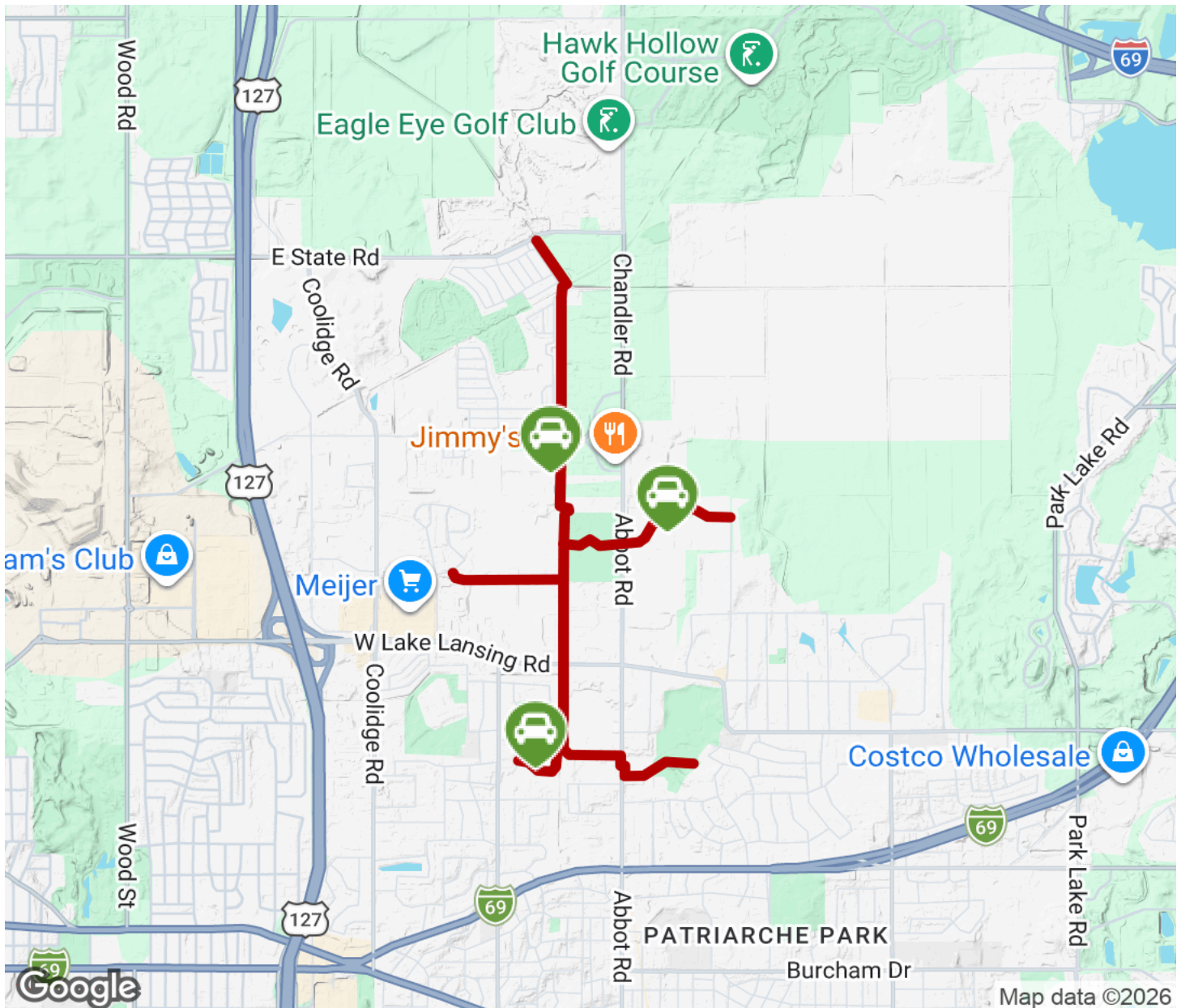
Parking & Trail Access
