Santa Fe Trail (Visalia) California



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Visalia's Santa Fe Trail extends south from the core of the city to its rural agricultural fringes. The northern half of the trail occupies a former Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe railroad corridor railroad corridor, while the southern half shares the space with a still active rail line. The entire length of the trail features smooth pavement, lights and landscaping.

In the future, the trail will be extended to meet Tulare's <u>Santa Fe Trail</u>, which occupies the same former rail corridor in the smaller city to Visalia's south.
