The Grimshaw Lake Nature Trail is part of the Amargosa River Natural Area, administered by the Bureau of Land Management.



The Grimshaw Lake Nature Trail is part of the Amargosa River Natural Area, administered by the Bureau of Land Management. The gravel trail follows an easy, flat route along the abandoned corridor of the historic Tonopah and Tidewater ("T&T") Railroad, built around the turn of the 20th century.

The trail passes through the open Tecopa Basin, where wildlife flourishes, particularly bird species. Nearby is the Tecopa Hot Springs County Park.
