The arrow-straight trail runs between Walnut and Henderson Avenues near downtown and features benches, lighted crosswalks with audible warnings and a drinking fountain. Several trees were planted along the trail to enhance the route.

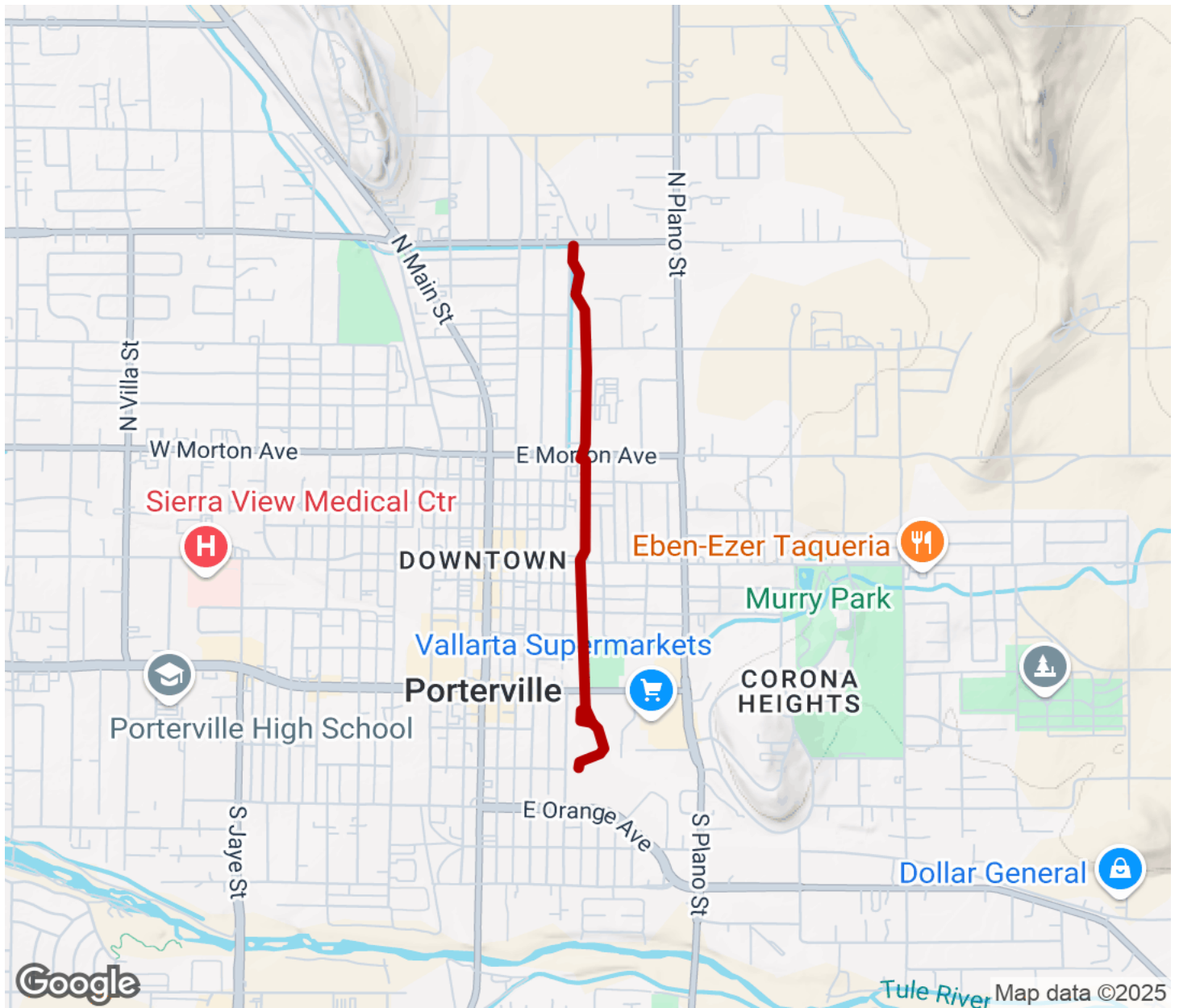
## Parking & Trail Access
