The Folsom Parkway Rail Trail extends from historic downtown Folsom to a connection with the Lake Natoma Trail north of US 50.



The Folsom Parkway Rail Trail extends from historic downtown Folsom to a connection with the <u>Lake Natoma</u> <u>Trail</u> north of US 50. The trail provides a direct connection to three light rail stations—Historic Folsom, Glenn and Iron Point—and two massive office parks, as well as the popular Folsom Premium Outlets retail center.

The utilitarian trail, which runs alongside the light rail line for most of its journey, also provides a direct trail connection to the immense <u>Humbug-Willow Creek Trail</u>.
