Point Douglas Regional Trail

Opened in the summer of 2017, the Point Douglas Regional Trail offers a picturesque link along the Mississippi River between



Although currently only 2.5 miles long, the trail will one day expand to offer a connection to Washington County's St. Croix Valley Trail in Minnesota, as well as trails in Dakota County.

Opened in the summer of 2017, the Point Douglas Regional Trail offers a picturesque link along the Mississippi River between Prescott, WI, and Hastings, MN, on a former railroad called the Peanut Line.

At either end of the pathway is a bridge crossing. At its western end, the trail heads over the Mississippi via a protected pedestrian walkway/bicyclist lane, providing safe passage across Highway 61. On the other side of the bridge, the trail connects to the [Mississippi River Regional Trail](#), which also connects to the [Vermillion River Regional Greenway](#).

On the Point Douglas Regional Trail's east end, it crosses the St. Croix River and heads into downtown Prescott.

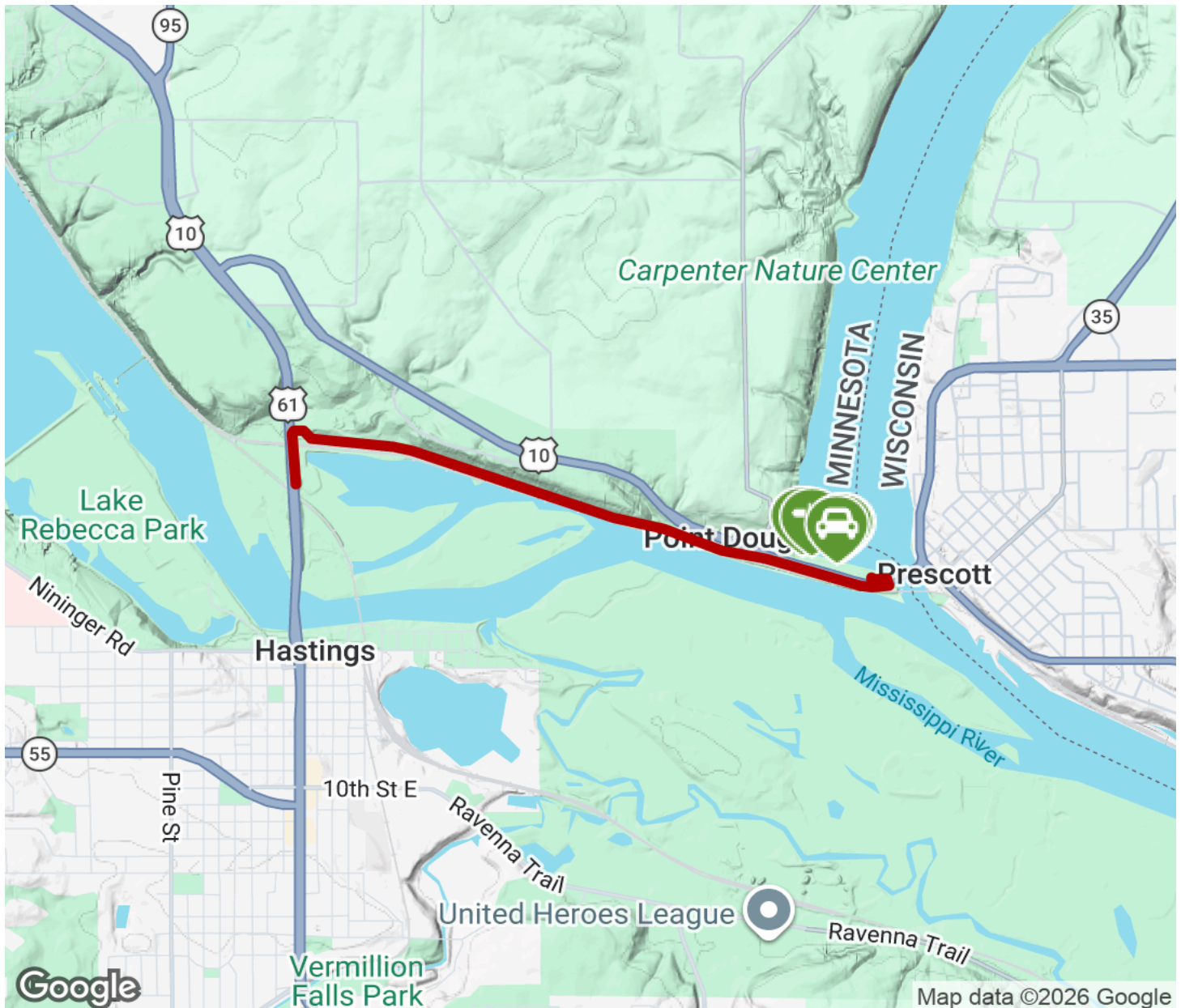
