The Bloomington Rail Trail is a 2-mile segment of crushed stone that runs through a suburban wooded corridor. The trail extends between W. Country Club Drive in the north and Church Lane in the south.

Just north of Church Lane, the trail intersects the <u>Clear</u> <u>Creek Rail Trail</u>. The trail now connects with the 1.8-mile <u>Limestone Greenway</u>, which continues south of Bloomington.


Parking & Trail Access
