Colorado

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The Mason Trail runs north-south through Fort Collins, paralleling McClellan Drive north of Horsetooth Road (CR 40) and the railroad tracks south of Horsetooth/CR 40.

The trail is a nice alternative to motorized transport and links the city's business and industrial districts with parks and neighborhoods.

The north end of the Mason Trail intersects with the [Spring Creek Trail](#). At the southern end it intersects with the [Fossil Creek Trail](#).


Parking & Trail Access
