Oakwoods is located at 1400 Oakwoods Lane in Findlay (off County Road 144).



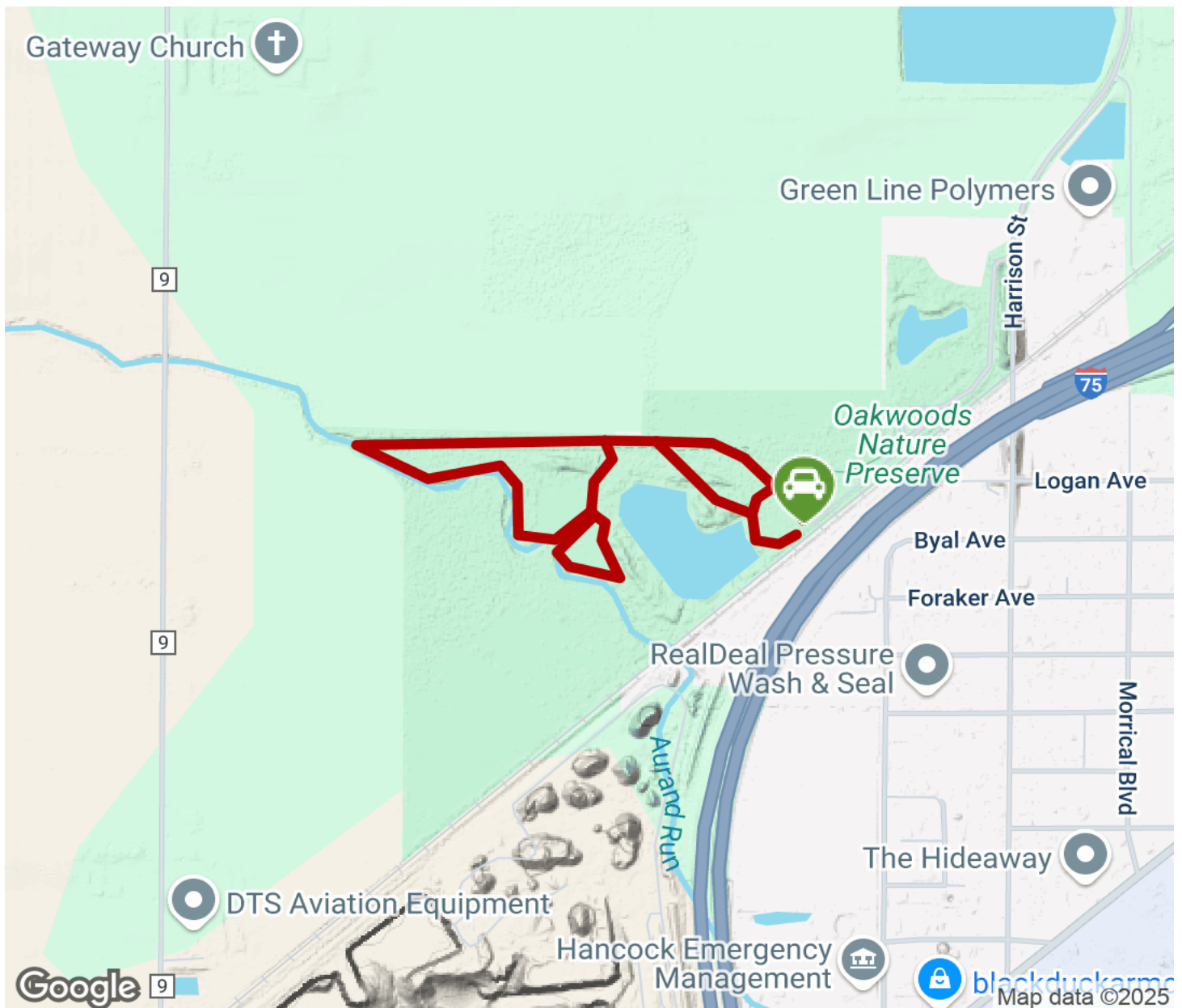
