The Phoenix Trail runs from College Park's former industrial area, now primarily containing airport hotels, to W. Point Avenue. The



The Phoenix Trail runs from College Park's former industrial area, now primarily containing airport hotels, to W. Point Avenue. The nearly 2-mile rail-trail, which was built on a railbanked CSX corridor, skirts the western edge of Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport.

The trail allows hotel guests to get some exercise, while also providing a convenient route to reach College Park's downtown area and MARTA train station via the sidewalk along W. Point Avenue. An underpass offers a safe crossing of busy Interstate 85 along the way.


Parking & Trail Access
