

Brighton East Rail Trail

The Brighton East Rail Trail was Fayette County's first, opening in 2007. The original 1-mile trail through recent residential

The Brighton East Rail Trail was Fayette County's first, opening in 2007. The original 1-mile trail through recent residential development between Bryant Road and Pleasant Ridge Park proved overwhelmingly popular with locals, and another 1-mile stretch of trail was completed in 2013. The newer portion of trail continues east from Pleasant Ridge Park through the tree-lined corridor to Walnut Grove Lane. Completion of this section was made possible by a local landowner's generous donation of a wide easement.

The most recent extension takes it west to Liberty Rd., where it meets the <u>Liberty Park Trail</u> via a pedestrian/cyclist bridge over the busy roadway, completed in 2021.

Eventually, city officials hope to extend the Brighton East
