## Parking & Trail Access

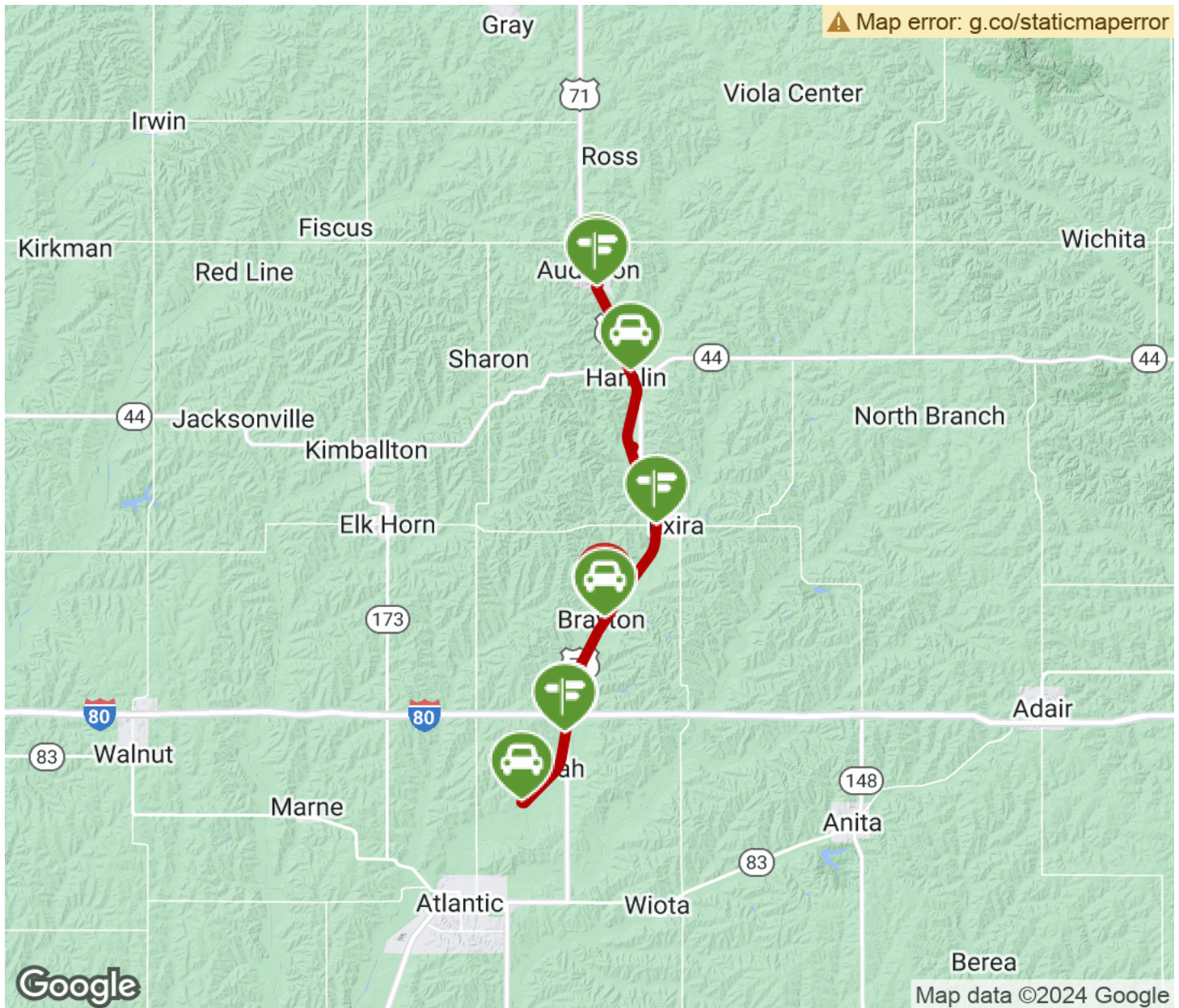
Parking can be found at many places along the trail, including these trailheads (from north to south):
