Parking & Trail Access

- Brayton: Old Glory Park on US Highway 71



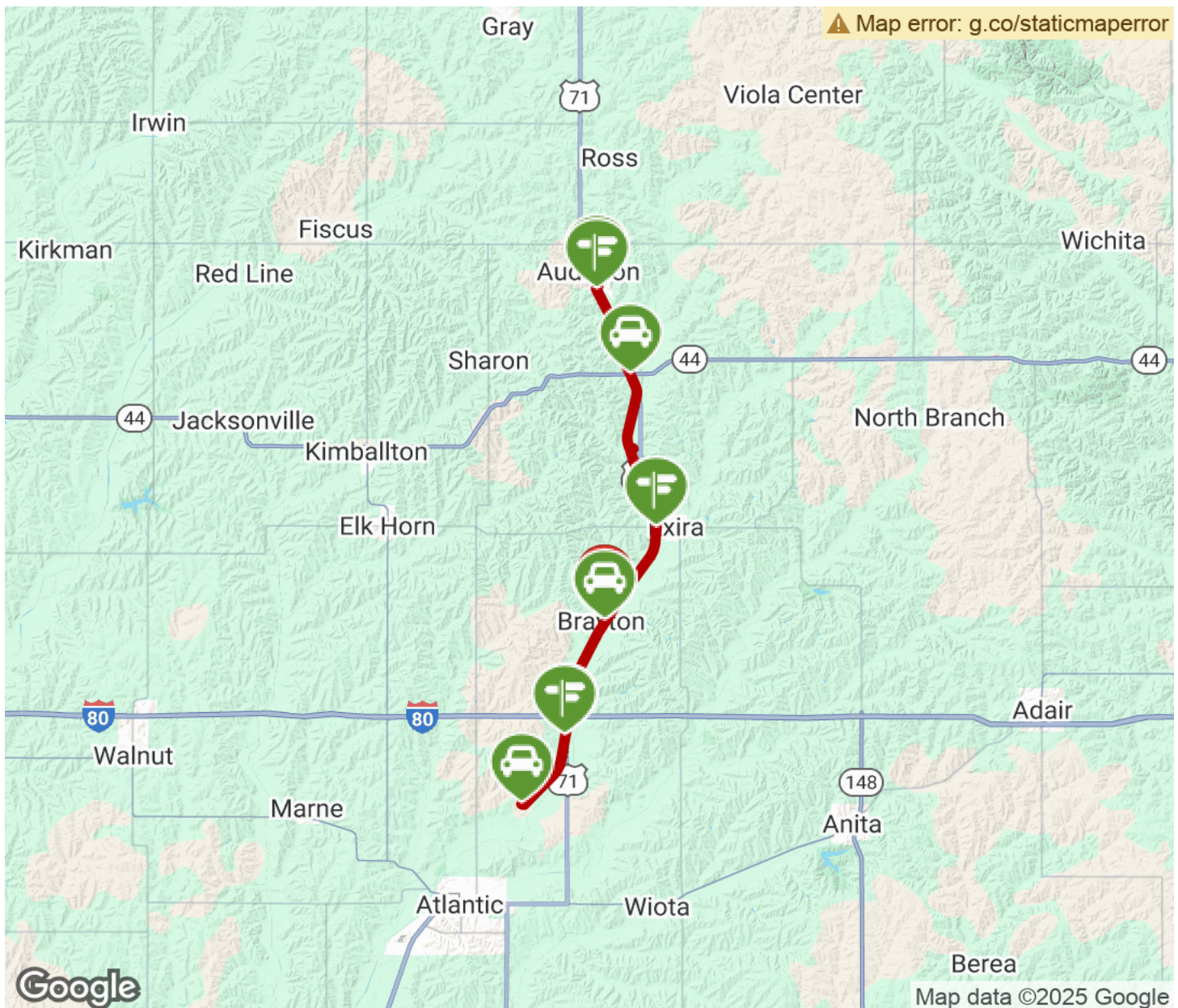
