John Overstreet Connector

Maryland

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The John Overstreet Connector is a 1.5-mile trail segment that links the [Baltimore & Annapolis Trail](#) and [BWI Trail](#). The short—but vital—trail is named after Overstreet, a retiree from Glen Burnie, Maryland, and a great advocate for bicycle safety in Maryland.

The connector begins at the end of the B&A Trail at Dorsey Road, passes through Saw Mill Creek Park and joins the BWI Trail at the intersection of Newport Road and Stewart Avenue.

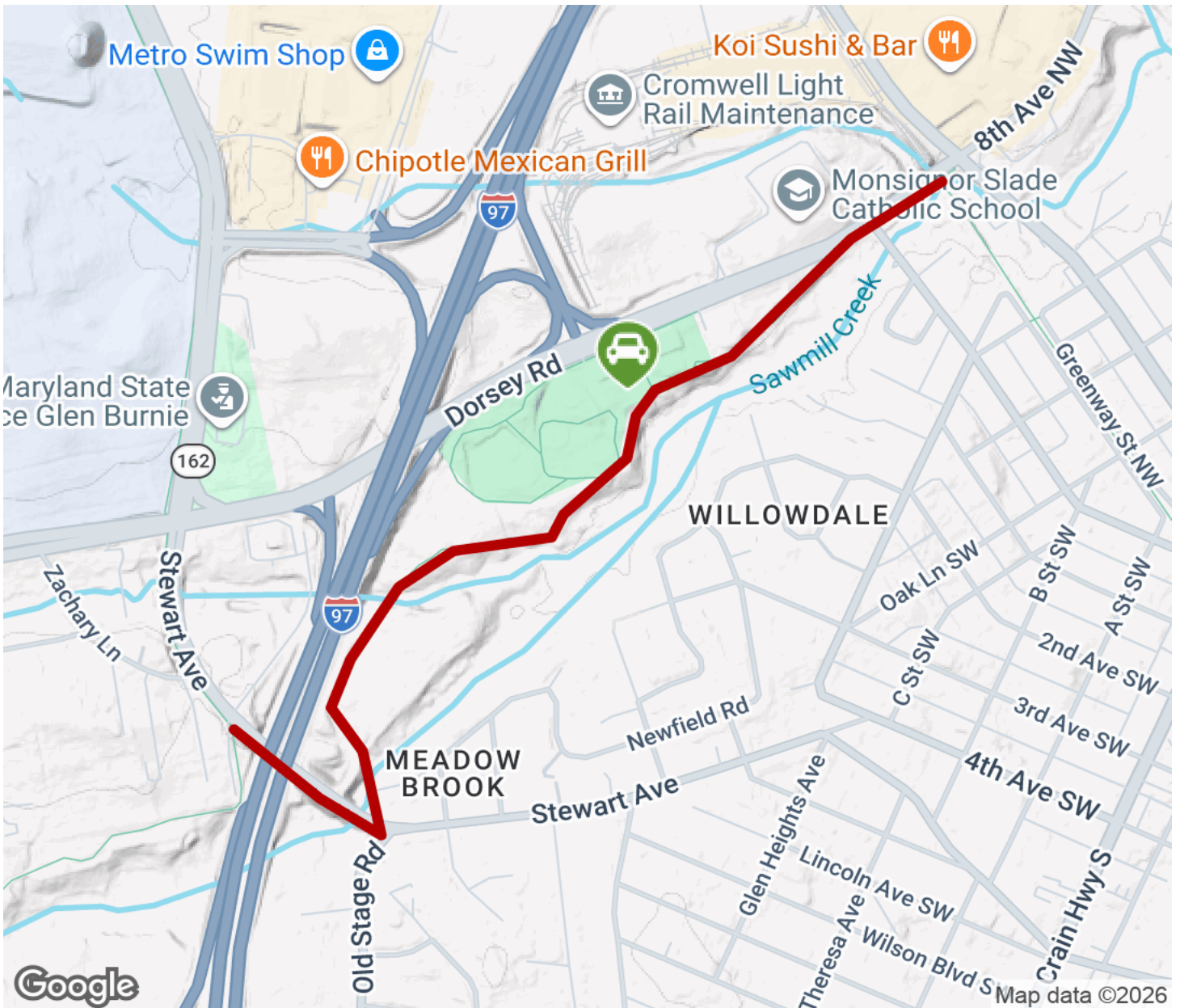
Parking & Trail Access
