The United States Avenue Trail, also know locally as the "Green Trail" travels through a primarily wooded landscape between



its midpoint. The park contains ball fields, concession stand, amphitheater, walking path and tot lot.

The United States Avenue Trail, also know locally as the "Green Trail" travels through a primarily wooded landscape between Foster Avenue and Crowland Ave. in Gibbsboro, New Jersey.

About the Route

At the Foster Avenue end, the trail leaves off from the police station. For the convenience of trail users there's a bike rack here. The setback of the trail into the woods helps to separate trail users from the traffic along United States Avenue. Paying homage to the town's history, a set of rails has been left in place between the trail surface and the roadway. Gibbsboro's evolving off road trail network intersects the rail trail in several locations. The entrance to Lindenwold Memorial Park intersects the trail at about
