The Fairfax Trail is 1.5 miles long and parallels the north side of Murray Ave, between Settle Street and Red Bank Road. The Murray



The Fairfax Trail is 1.5 miles long and parallels the north side of Murray Ave, between Settle Street and Red Bank Road. The Murray Road portion overlaps with the Murray Road Hike/ Bike Trail. There are plans to link the Fairfax Trail to another trail planned to run between Cincinnati and Cleveland.

In 2021 the trail was extended along the former trolley line (now utility corridor) within the median of Murray Avenue, bringing the trail out east to Plainville Road. A separate extension of the Wasson Way trail also brought that trail just a short distance from the southern endpoint of the Murray Path, enhancing the area's network of walking and cycling routes. The Fairfax Trail is part of the coast to coast American Discovery Trail.


Parking & Trail Access
