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In 2021 the trail was extended along the former trolley line (now utility corridor) within the median of Murray Avenue, bringing the trail out east to Plainville Road. A separate extension of the [Wasson Way](#) also brought that trail just a short distance from the southern endpoint of the Murray Path, enhancing the area's network of walking and cycling routes.

The Murray Path is part of the coast to coast American Discovery Trail.

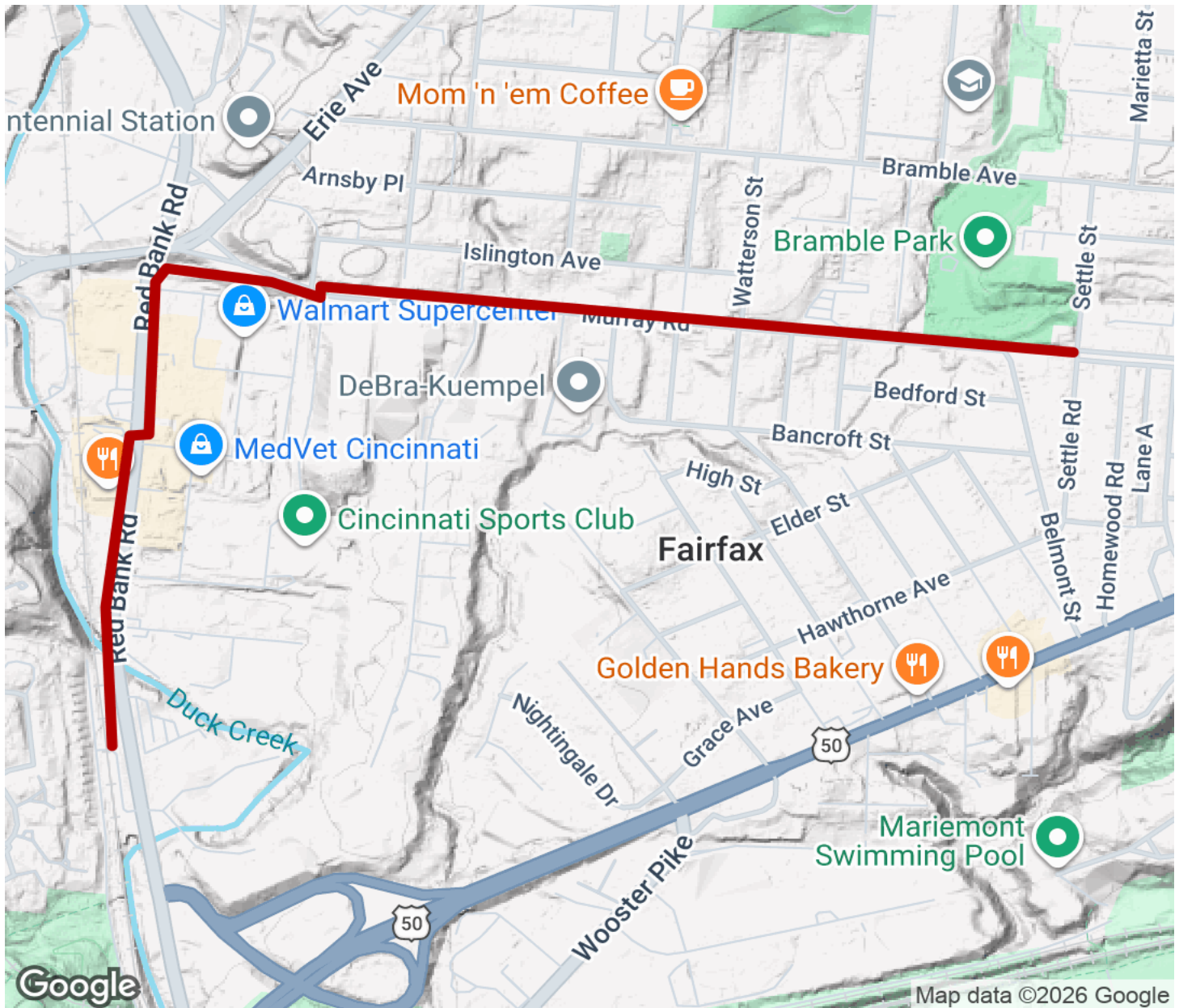
