The Anacostia Tributary Trail System runs between Colmar Manor Community Park and Wheaton-Glenmont, Franklin Knolls, and Hollywood.

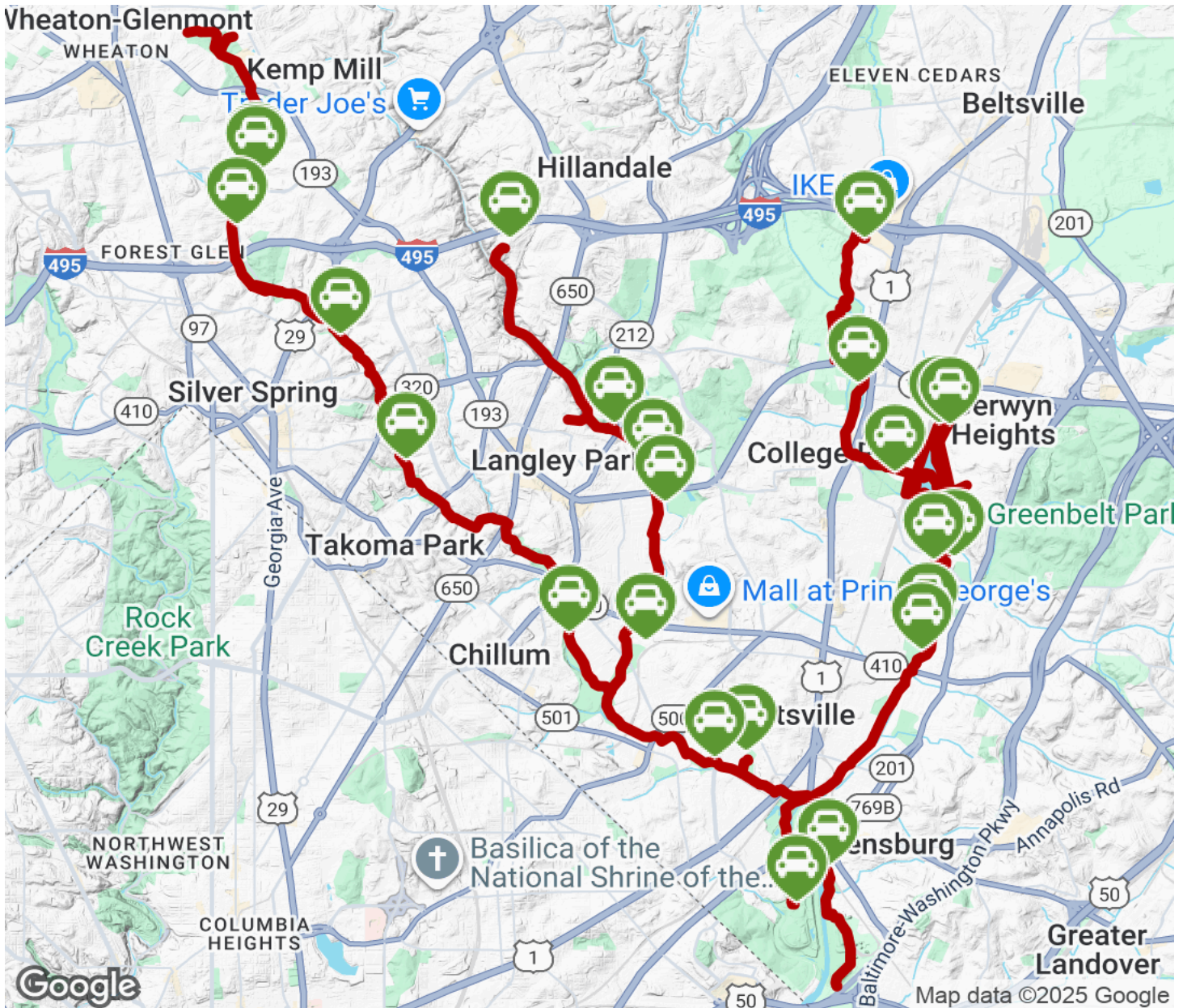
