Parking for the Union City Gateway Trail is available adjacent to Railroad Park on Stateline Street in Union City.



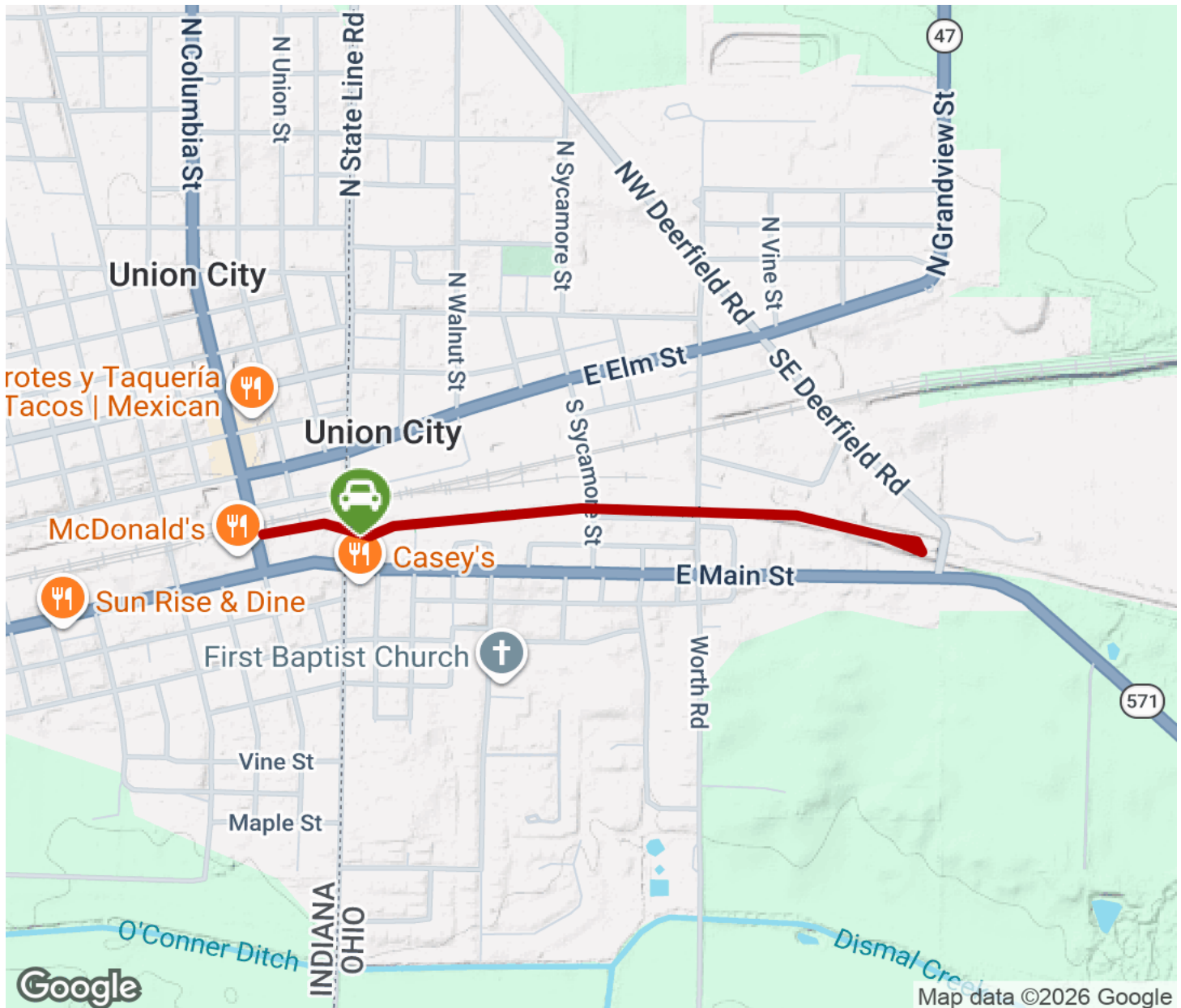
