The Trolley Line Trail is a 2.8-mile paved trail in West Windsor, New Jersey. The trail follows the former right of way of the Fast Line electric trolley that connected Trenton and New Brunswick in the early 20th century. The trail passes through West Windsor Community Park where there are picnic facilities, soccer fields, baseball fields, tennis courts, dog parks, basketball courts and rest rooms. The West Windsor Waterworks swimming pools and Skateboard Park are also located in the community park.

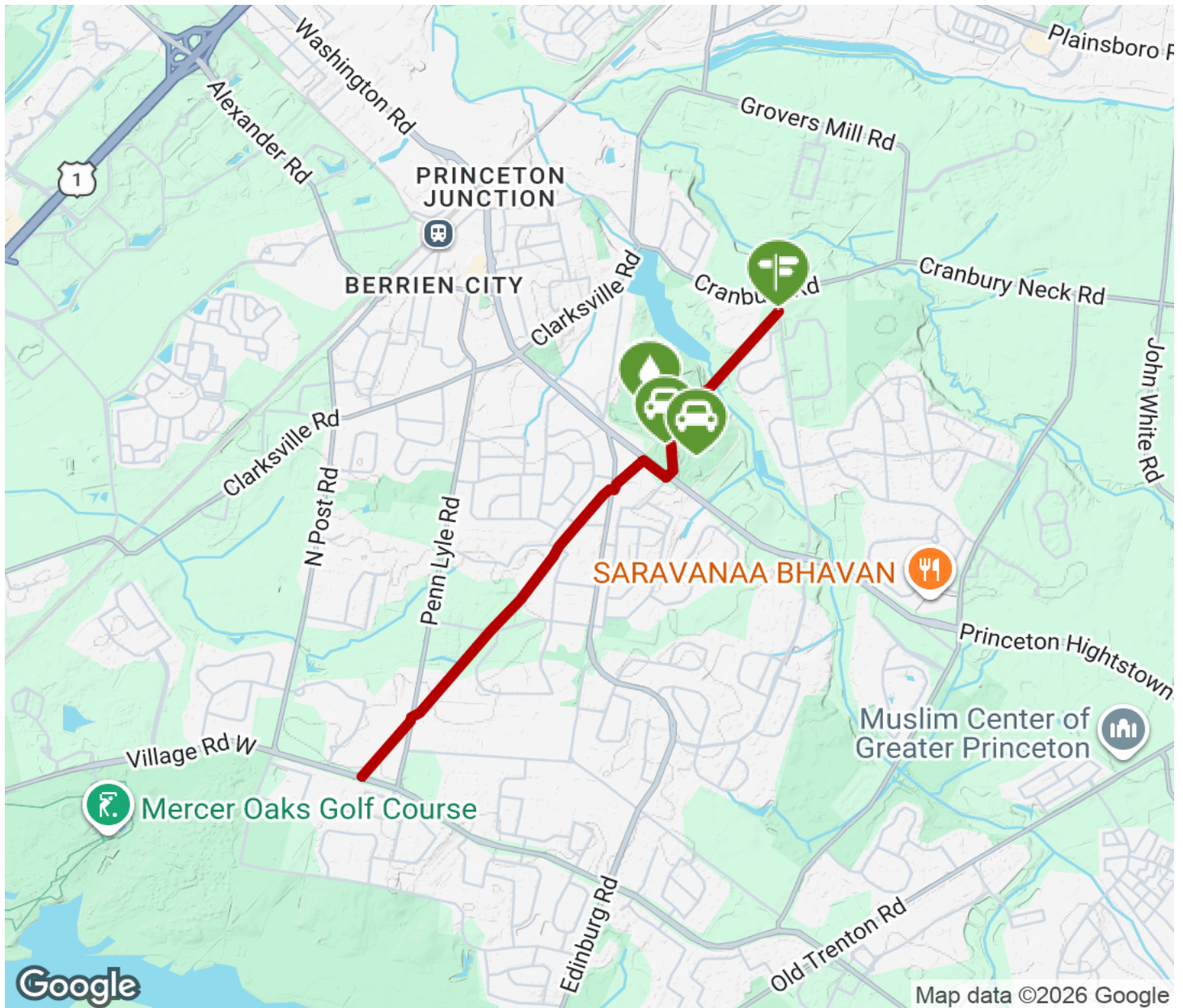
Parking & Trail Access
