Newton Blackmour State Trail *Wisconsin*



The Newton Blackmour State Trail runs about 21 miles in eastern Wisconsin from the outskirts of New London to Seymour, roughly



The Newton Blackmour State Trail runs about 21 miles in eastern Wisconsin from the outskirts of New London to Seymour, roughly paralleling State Highway 54. Along the way, it passes through the communities of Shiocton and Black Creek as well.

From its eastern end at Vandenheuvel Road, trail users can continue their ride another 9 miles on the <u>Duck Creek</u> <u>Trail</u> to the outskirts of Green Bay.

The crushed-stone pathway is open to cyclists, walkers, equestrians, cross-country skiers, snowshoers and snowmobiles and is also wheelchair accessible. Snowmobiles are not allowed on the Duck Creek Trail, however. A new addition is in the works! Currently, the trail is being extended into New London.

On-street parking is available in Black Creek and Seymour.
