The Town Loop is a popular trail that encircles the scenic community of Mammoth Lakes, providing access to a host of neighborhoods, businesses and recreational amenities. The vast majority of the system is off-road, with the few share-the-road stretches along low-stress neighborhood streets.

As the central component of Mammoth Lakes' impressive trail network, many of the town's other paths feed into it, including the [College Connector Path](#), [Main Street Connector](#), [Meridian Connector](#), [Sierra Park Connector](#), [North Waterford Connector](#) and [Lodestar Connector](#). The entire system features smooth pavement and a stunning backdrop of mountains and woodlands.

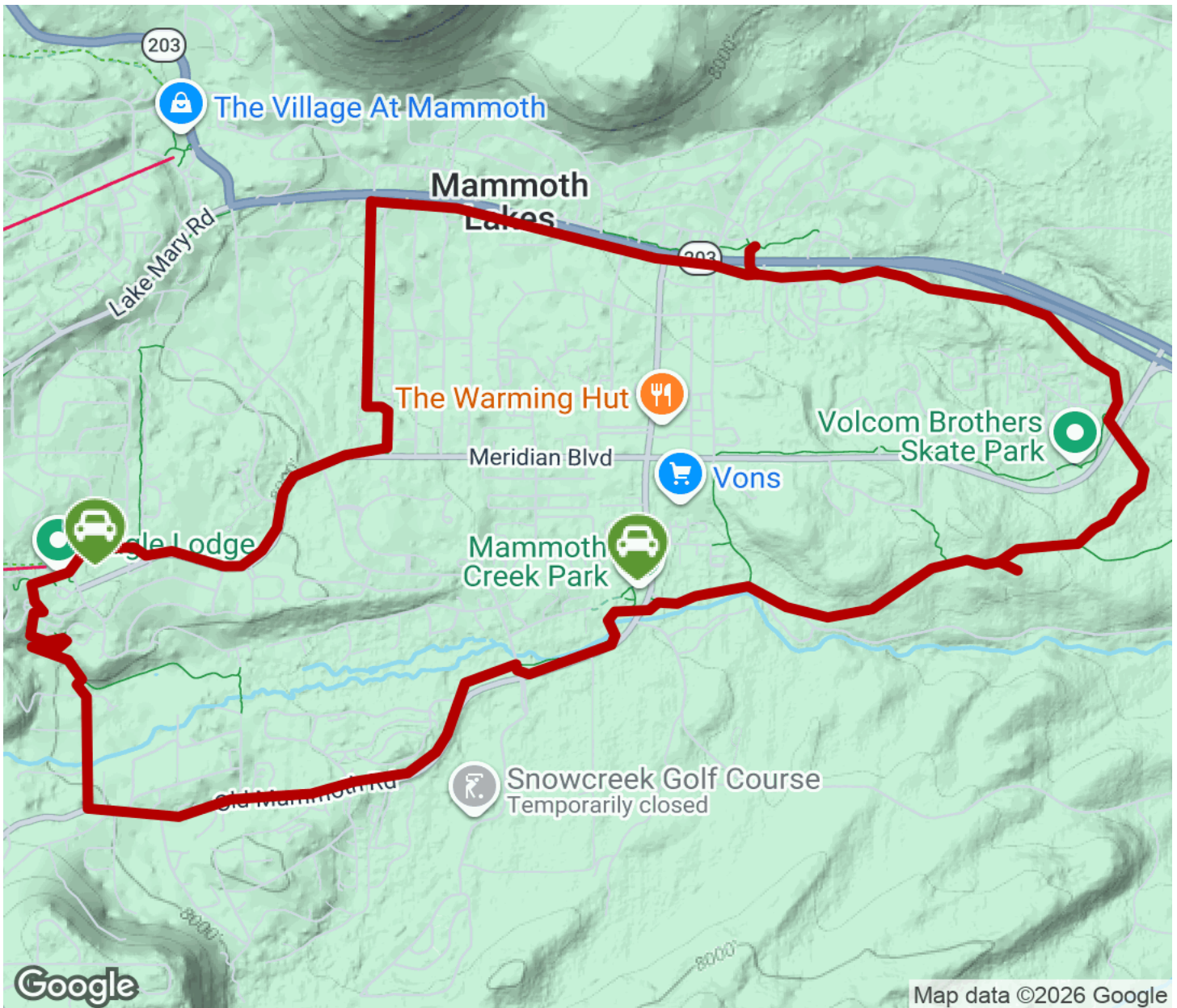
Parking & Trail Access
