The Shady Rest Path is a scenic paved trail that winds north from a junction with the short Main Street Connector to Shady Rest Park.



The Shady Rest Path is a scenic paved trail that winds north from a junction with the short <u>Main Street</u> <u>Connector</u> to Shady Rest Park. Open from May to November, the park features several athletic fields, as well as a playground, picnic area, concession stand and restrooms. Along the way, trail users pass through dense woodlands adjacent to popular campgrounds.
