California

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The Meridian Connector is a useful link between Mammoth Lakes' elementary, middle and high schools and the popular [Town Loop](#), which encircles the community. Midway, a spur connects trail users to residences on Wagon Wheel Road, while the Volcom Brothers Skate Park at the trail's eastern end is a popular destination for younger residents and visitors.

Like many of Mammoth Lakes' trails, the Meridian Connector features smooth pavement and a stunning backdrop of mountains and woodlands. From the trail's western end, cross Meridian Boulevard to pick up the short [Sierra Park Connector](#) to access the Mammoth Lakes Library and retail destinations, or take the newer [College Connector Path](#) to reach Cerro Coso Community College.

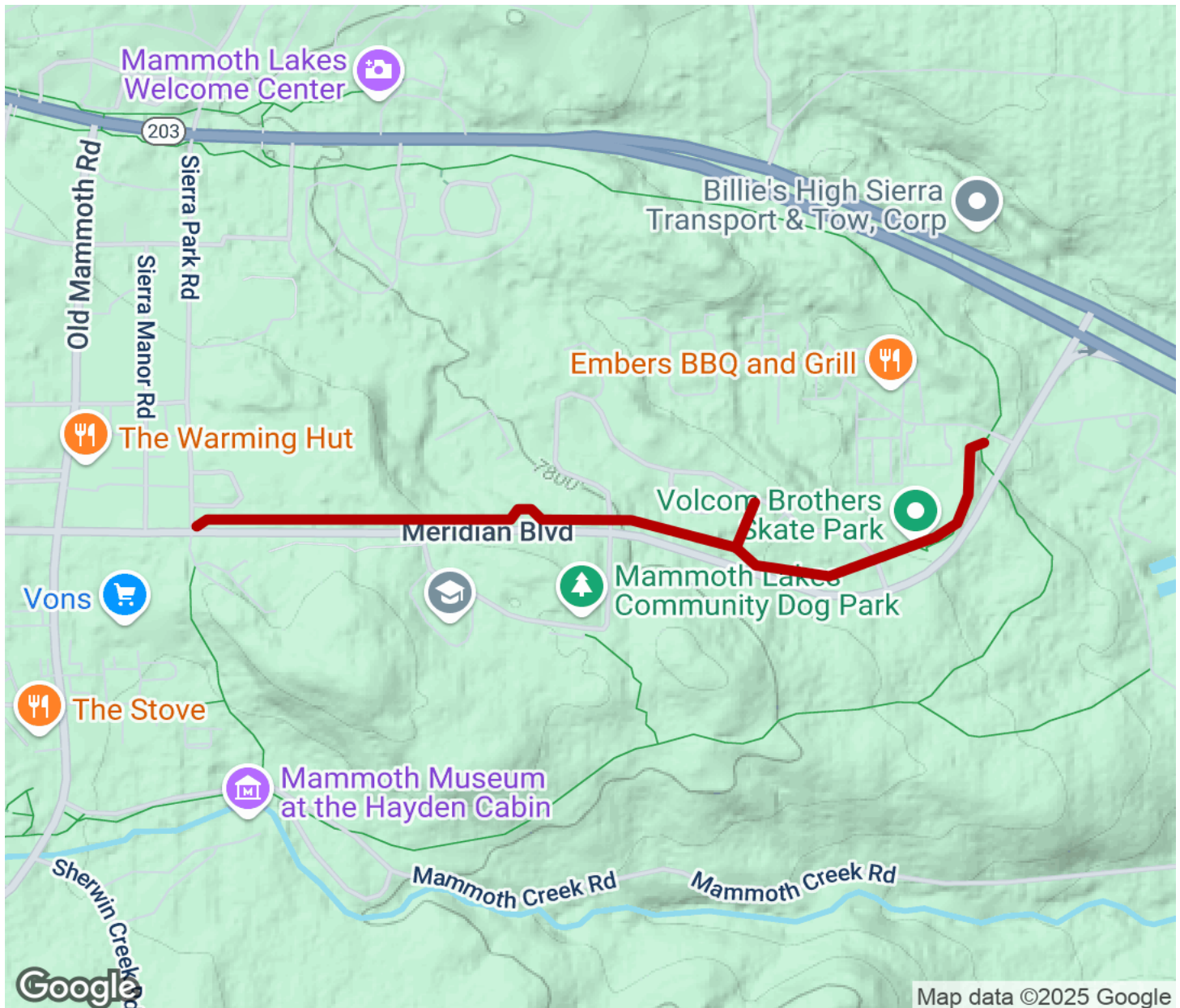
Parking & Trail Access
