The Inland Rail Trail runs for 10.5 miles through the San Diego County communities of Escondido, San Marcos and parts of Vista.

About the Route

The setting for the Inland Rail Trail between Escondido, San Marcos and Vista is urban with the rail line on one side and parallel roads nearby. The paved rail-trail runs alongside the Sprinter light rail service connecting Escondido to Oceanside.

A short, disconnected half-mile portion of trail was also constructed between North Drive and Melrose Drive in Vista and the edge of Oceanside, which will eventually be joined to the rest of the trail.

Connections

The trail gives access to Palomar College and the Escondido Transit Center, where it also meets the <u>Escondido Creek Bike</u> <u>Path</u>.

In the future, the trail will extend a total of 21 miles to a terminus at the <u>Coastal Rail Trail</u> on Wisconsin Avenue in Oceanside.
