The trail is divided in two by active railroad tracks and Gateway Drive, but the city is working on constructing a new undercrossing to bridge the gap. Eventually, expansion eastward will complete the trail, which is planned to one day span Madera city limits.

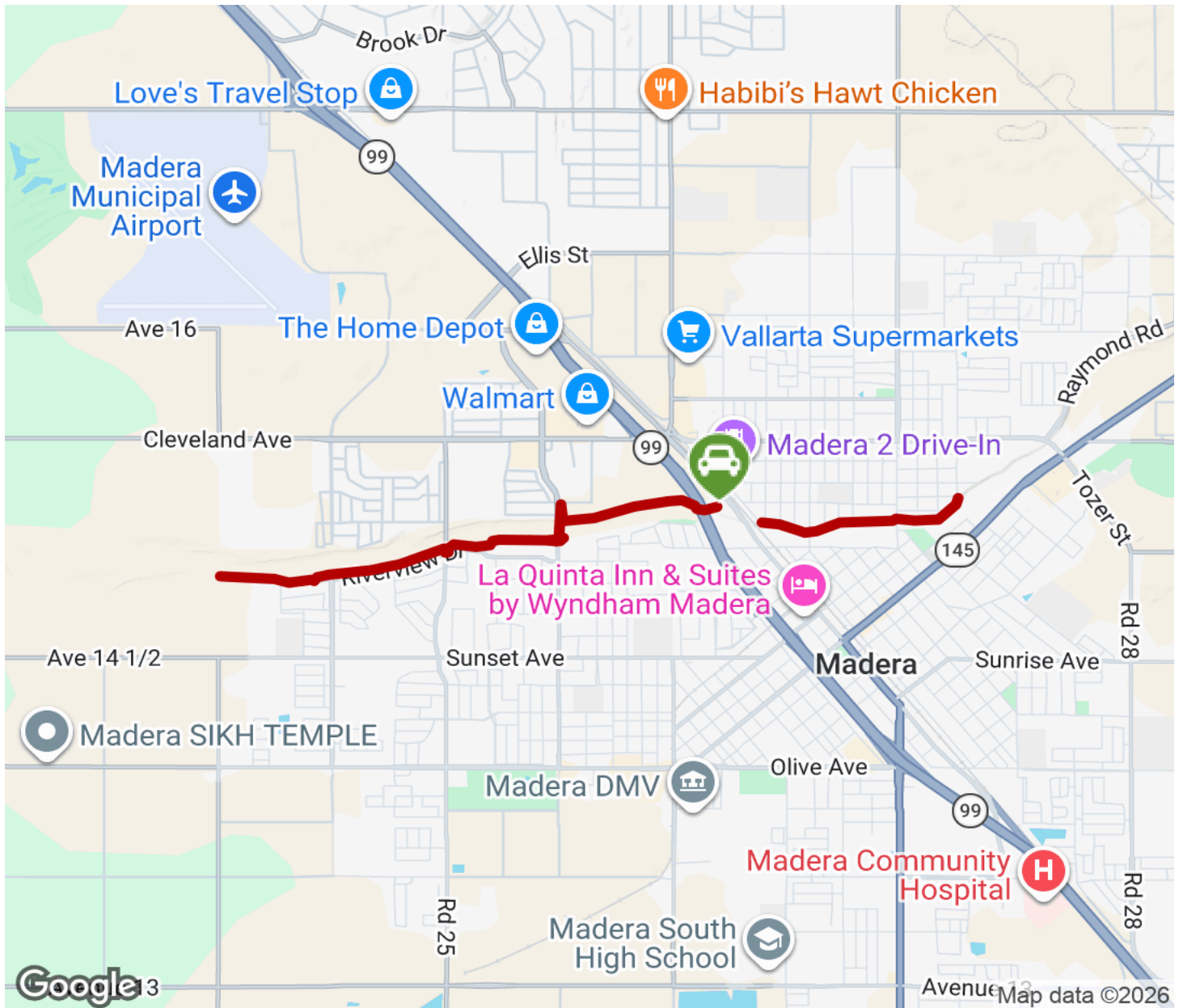
## Parking & Trail Access
