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The Vernon McCullough Fresno River Trail runs along the dry river in Madera, offering a recreation and transportation amenity for the city's residents and visitors. The trail is divided in two by active railroad tracks and Gateway Drive, but the city is working on constructing a new undercrossing to bridge the gap. Eventually, expansion eastward will complete the trail, which is planned to one day span Madera city limits.

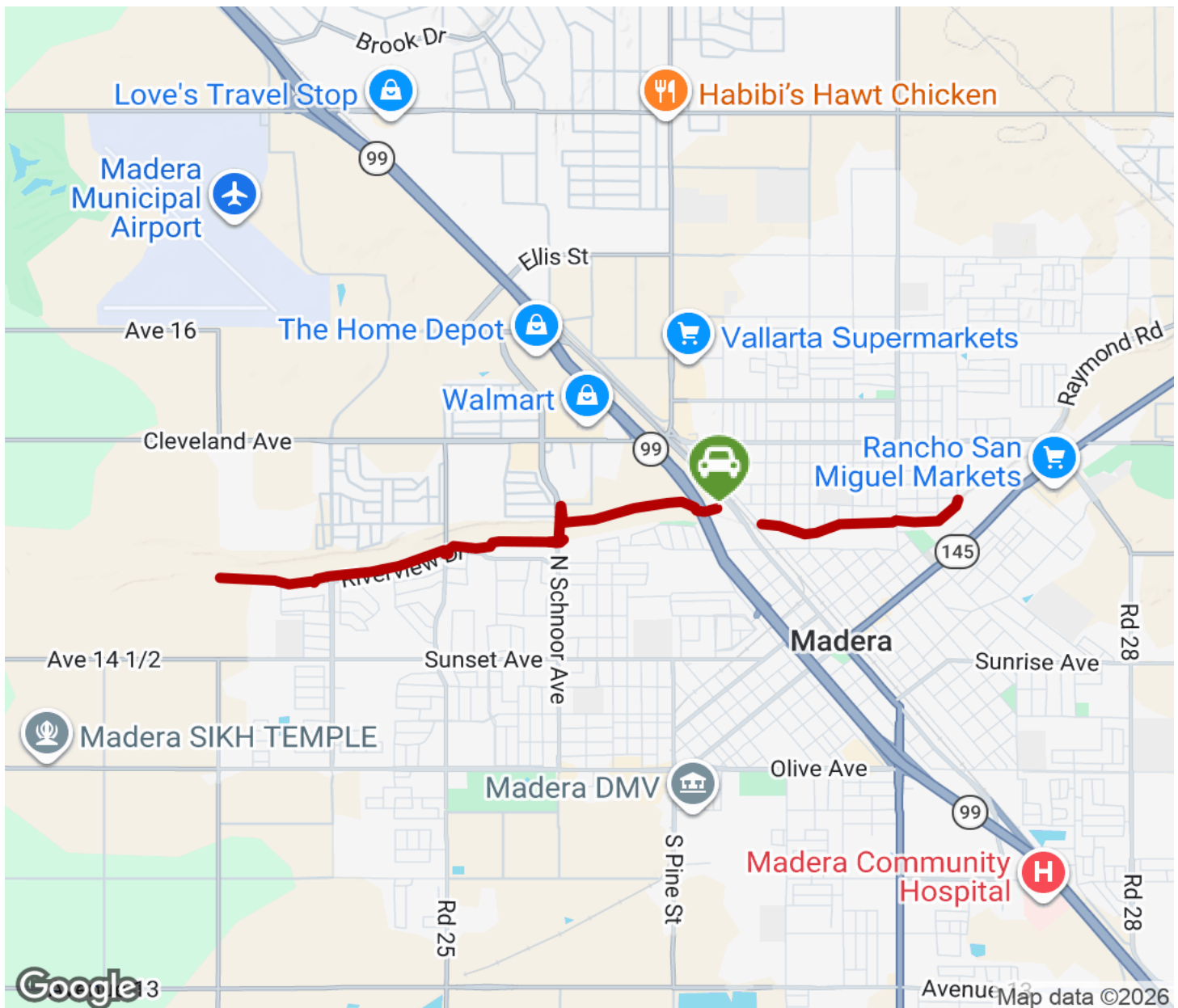
Parking & Trail Access
