The Brooks-Scanlon Rail Trail winds through Deschutes National Forest. Running north from the City of Bend to the City of Sisters,



The Brooks-Scanlon Rail Trail winds through Deschutes National Forest. Running north from the City of Bend to the City of Sisters, the gravel trail follows a former logging road for about 27 miles.

Parts of the trail can be quite hilly and are best suited to mountain bikes. Camping is available and the Deschutes National Forest offers a variety of recreational activities.
