Heading south to North Haverhill the trails runs along a series of corn fields right next to Rt. 10 and ends at the village line. Next to some of the corn fields the trail is covered with wood chips which requires biking on the grass. The trail reaches its southern end at Clark Pond Rd. in North Haverhill


Parking & Trail Access
