Fairfax County Parkway Trail

Virginia

The Fairfax County Parkway Trail parallels Fairfax County Parkway/State Route 286 on its route across Fairfax County,



side paths along its route, as well as the popular [W&OD Trail](#) near Reston and the [Cross County Trail](#) in West Springfield.

The [Ox Road Sidepath](#) bridges a gap in the trail near Fairfax Station.

The Fairfax County Parkway Trail parallels Fairfax County Parkway/State Route 286 on its route across Fairfax County, Virginia.

About the Route

While the paved trail varies in width and condition, most of the trail is usable for walking, biking and inline skating. The southernmost segment from Newington to Fort Belvoir is disconnected from the bulk of the pathway, and there is another gap in the trail near Fairfax Station, which can be bridged using the Ox Road Sidepath.

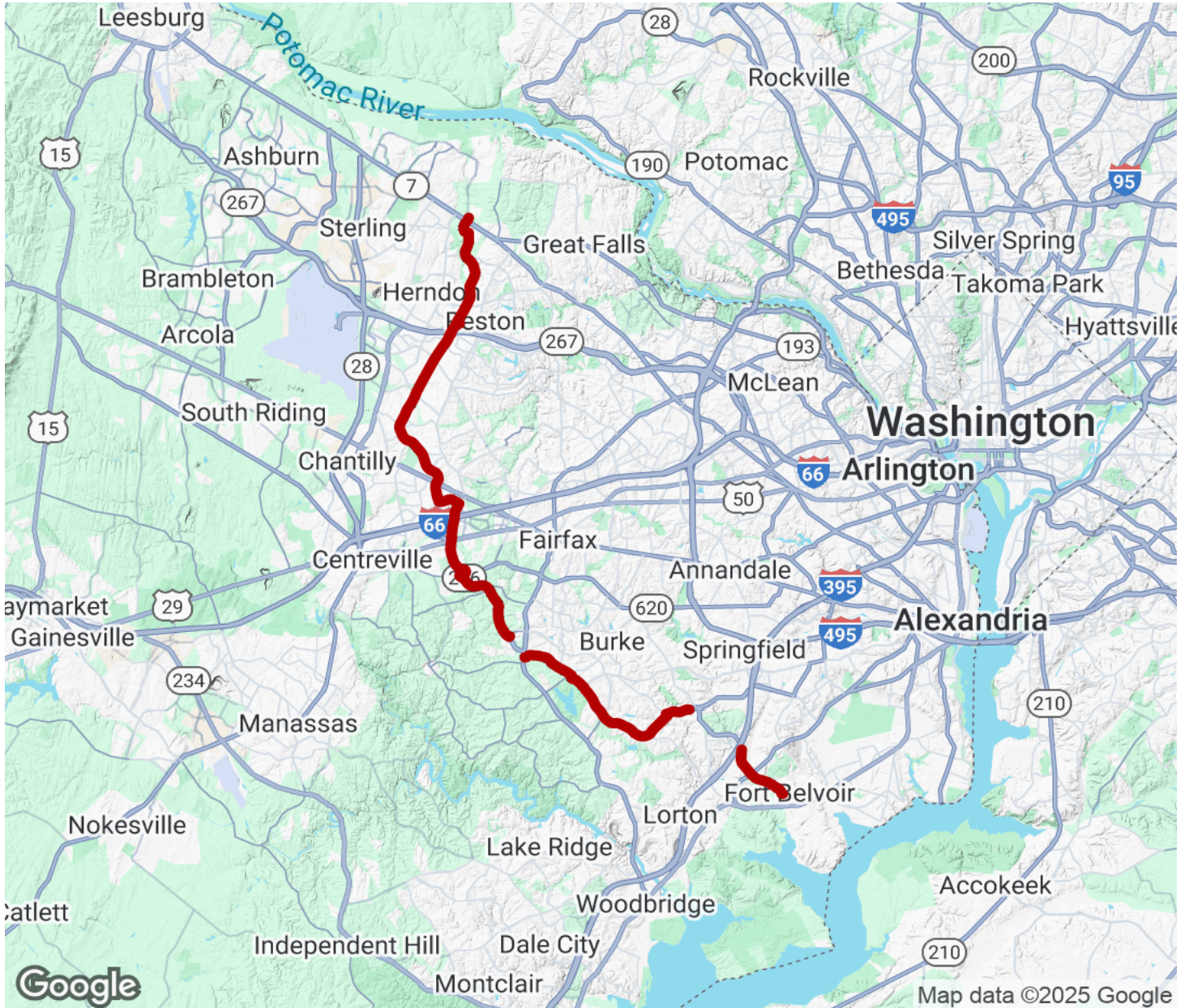
