Overview The Arbor Hills Trail is a 3-mile loop through the Arbor Hills Nature Preserve. The paved pathway through the 200-acre



the western end of the initial loop. As the loop meanders through the preserve, it passes over a stream in two places and provides access to numerous unpaved trails throughout the nature preserve.

The Arbor Hills Nature Preserve also has multiple picnic tables right off the Arbor Hills Trail, located near the parking lot area.

Overview

The Arbor Hills Trail is a 3-mile loop through the Arbor Hills Nature Preserve. The paved pathway through the 200-acre wooded preserve also offers access to unpaved hiking and mountain biking trails.

About the Route

Only 20 miles north of downtown Dallas, the tree-lined Arbor Hills Trail snakes through the nature preserve. The loop is accessible from both the north and south end of the Arbor Hills Nature Preserve parking lot. The paved trail consists of two connected loops through the preserve. The bigger of the two loops is accessible from the parking lot. The entry points for the second loop sit on

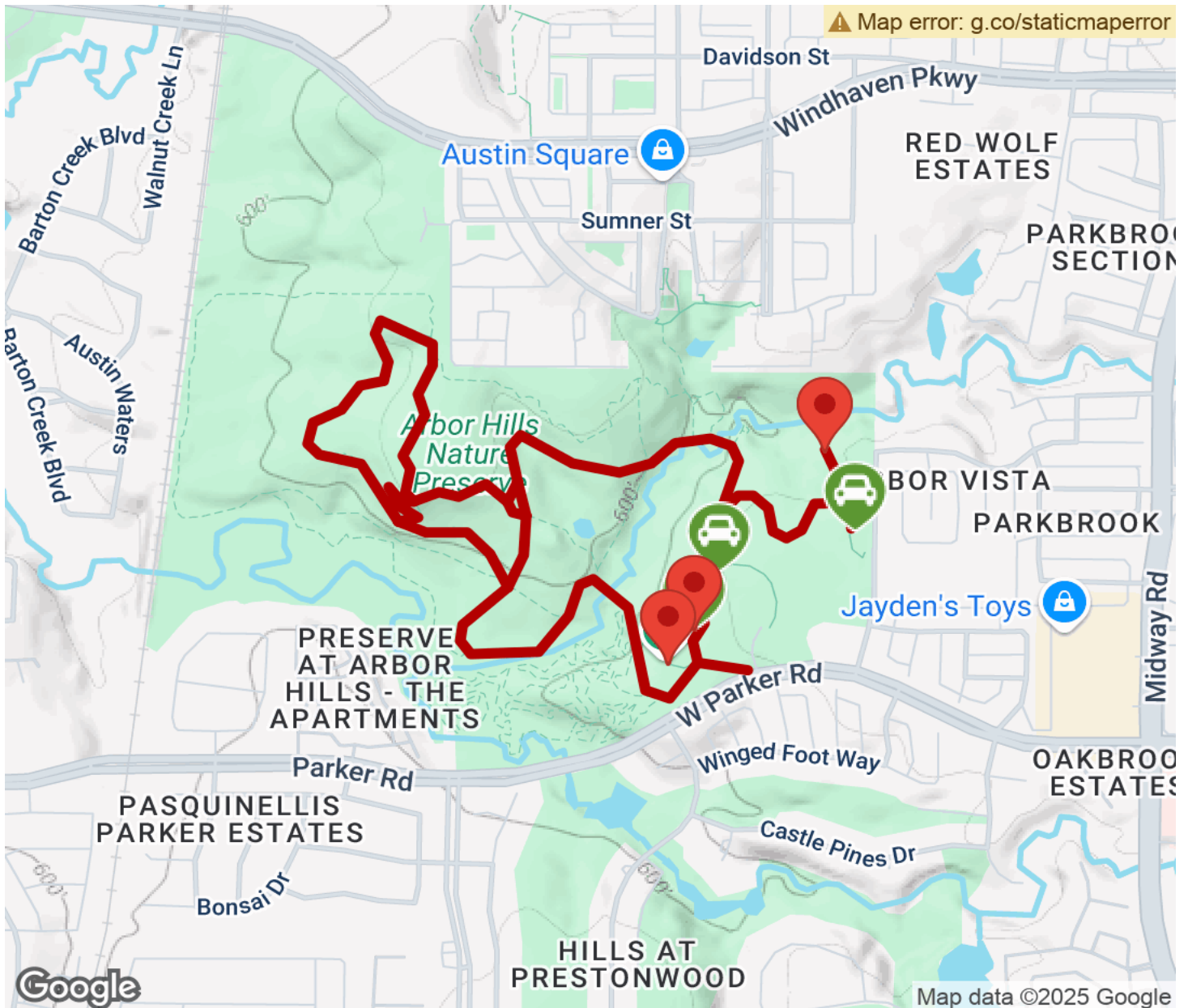
