Kings Mountain Gateway Trail

North Carolina

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Kings Mountain Gateway Trail is situated in a beautiful natural park setting offering a picnic shelter, restrooms, drinking fountains, and parking. Much of the park is heavily wooded and the trail is suitable for hiking and biking. The trail travels through property that was once used for mining and, along the way, there are two hills made of rock removed from the old quarries.

The trail is part of a regional trail network called the [Carolina Thread Trail](#), which will link 15 counties across North and South Carolina.

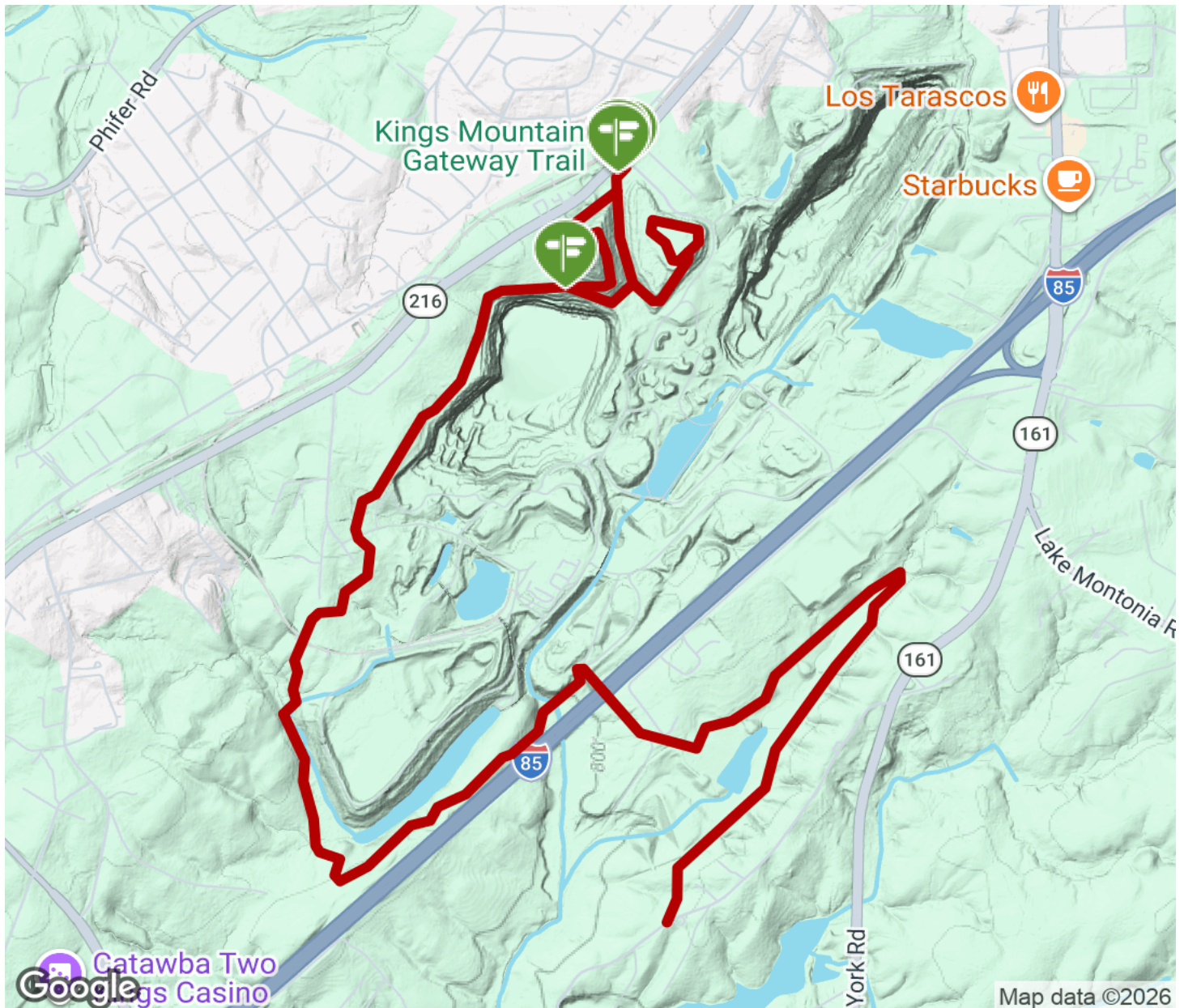
Parking & Trail Access
