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The Trinity Levee Trail is a part of the City of Dallas trails system. This gravel leveetop trails doubles as a maintenance road for the levee. Access is available from Westmoreland Road.

A disconnected 1.1 mile segment begins south of I-35 and connects to the [Santa Fe Trestle Trail](#). The trail is proposed to be improved and expanded to 22.6 miles of trail and link several city parks.

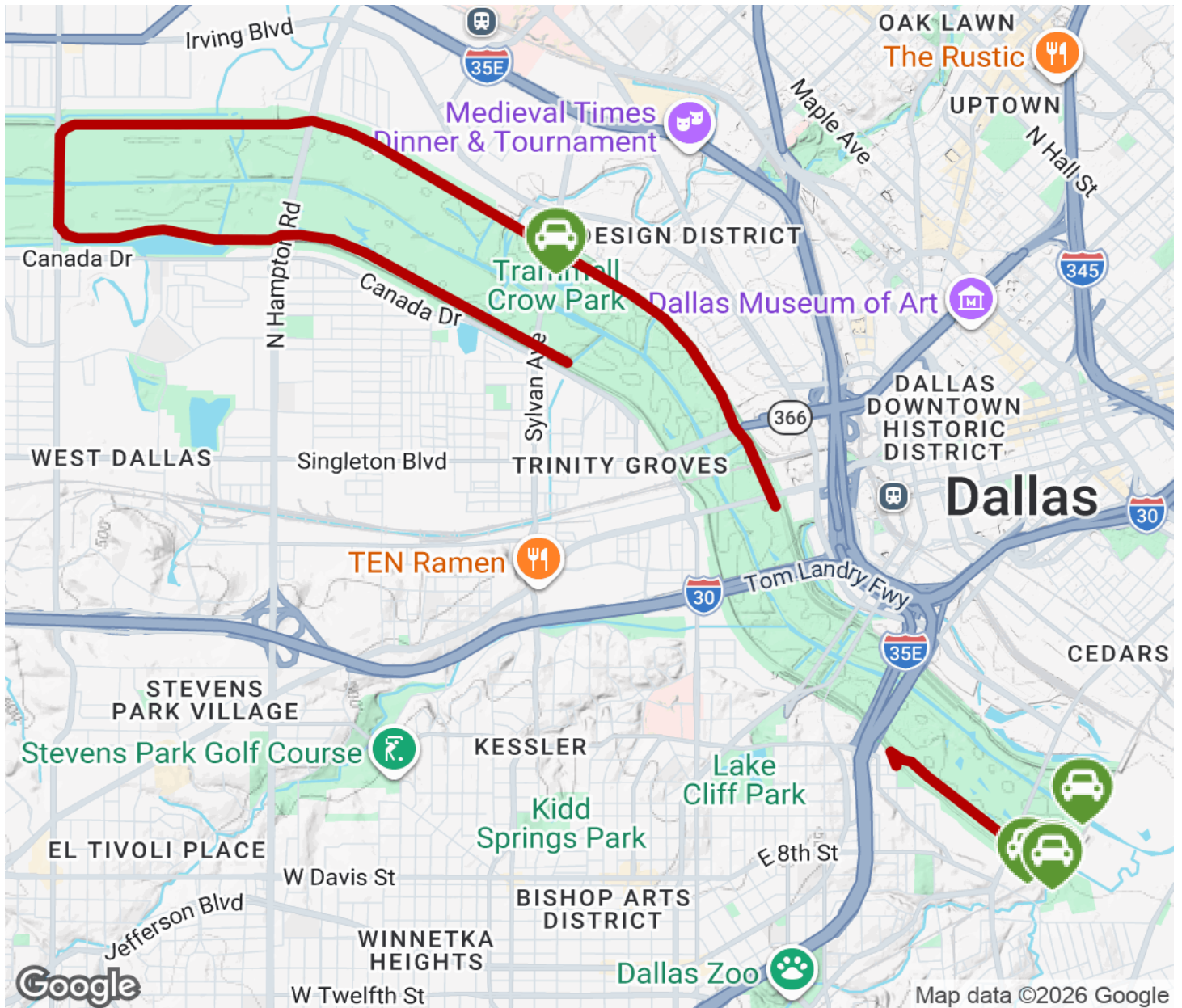
