SoPac Trail Texas



The SoPac Trail is a part of the City of Dallas trails system. This trail, located in East Dallas, runs for 5.7 miles along an unused



The SoPac Trail is a part of the City of Dallas trails system. This trail, located in East Dallas, runs for 5.7 miles along an unused Southern Pacific (SoPac) railbed owned by DART. While the tracks and ties of the old railroad are long gone, the corridor's gentle grade and ample tree cover are precisely what makes this a great place to walk and bike.

About the Route

Leaving off from the trail's northern endpoint along Greenville Avenue, the trail very briefly heads north and steadily goes uphill before curving 180 degrees to head south and then over a bridge, which crosses above Greenville Avenue. Crossing this bridge, trail users look down and see where you started.

The route continues south to Winstead Drive, running along the edge of Harry Moss Park and then through industrial, commercial, and residential areas. In most cases, the trail either crosses intersecting streets via bridges or underpasses, which allows riders to cross safely while maintaining their momentum.

The southern end of the trail runs by several impressive sites in here including the local hatchery, Tokalon Park, Lakewood Park, and the White Rock Boathouse.

Connections

In the Ridgewood Park neighborhood, the trail connects to the <u>Flag Pole Hill Trail</u> and the <u>Ridgewood Trail</u>.

In Lakewood Park, the White Rock Lake Park Loop Trail is accessible nearby.

At the southern end of the trail, trail users can connect with the <u>Santa Fe Trail</u>.
