The trail runs between apartments and an active rail line. In the east, the path originates in Park Ridge Park, which offers playground equipment and a small picnic shelter. For this reason, the trail is occasionally called the Park Ridge Bike Trail.

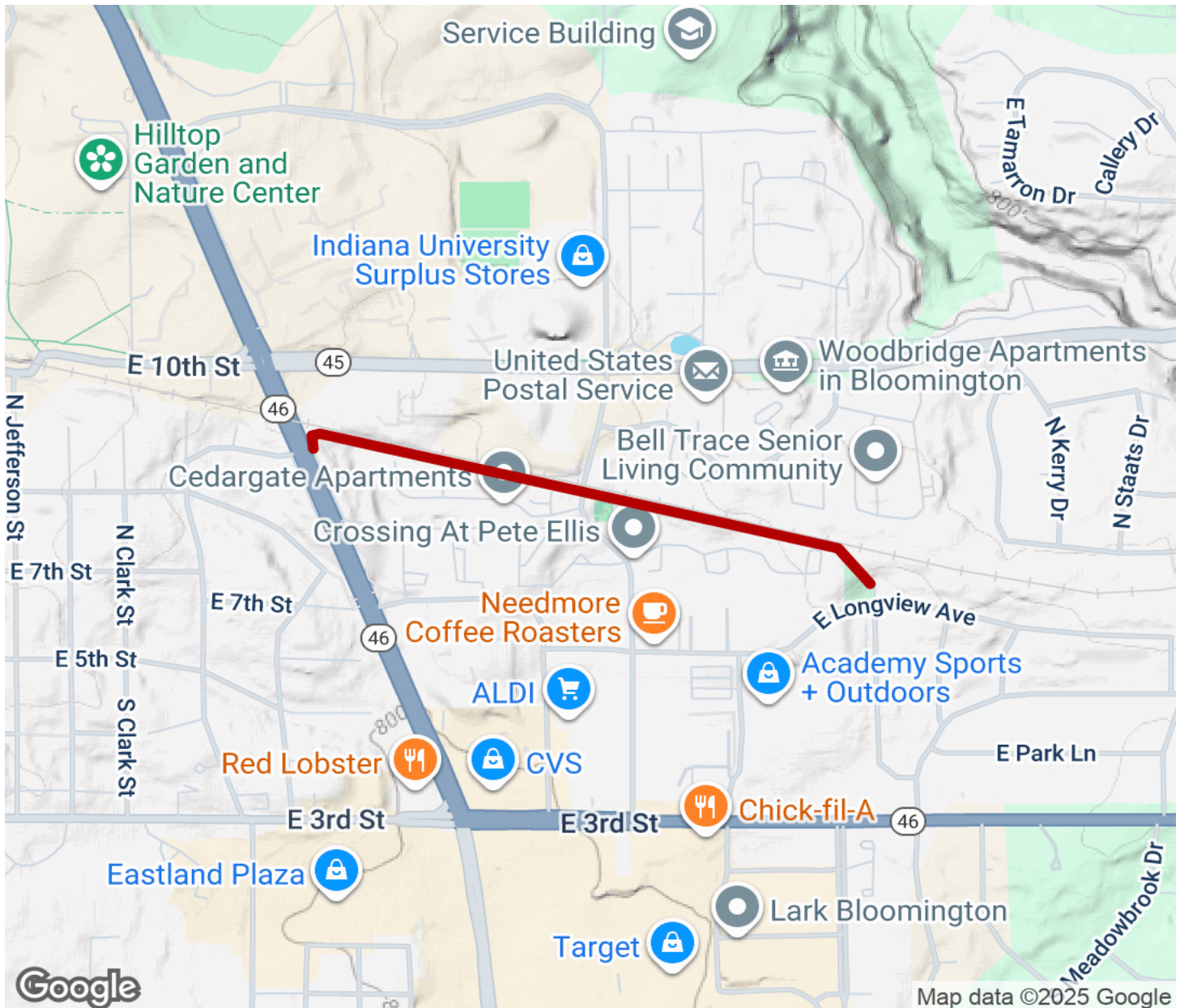
