Clarksville Greenway

The 9-mile Clarksville Greenway follows an abandoned rail bed on the outskirts of Clarksville north of town and offers 3 more miles of



miles, the trail winds its way along both the Red and Cumberland Rivers, right through the heart of Clarksville. Where the greenway crosses College St., the trail is also called the [Upland Trail](#), aptly named for the trail bridge that takes you over the road. This 0.6-mile trail takes trail users further south through town.

The southernmost section of the Clarksville Greenway is a series of winding trails within Liberty Park, 1190 Cumberland Dr.

Connections

The Clarksville Greenway includes both the [Cumberland Riverwalk](#) and the [Upland Trail](#).

The 9-mile Clarksville Greenway follows an abandoned rail bed on the outskirts of Clarksville north of town and offers 3 more miles of greenway south of the Red River.

About the Route

The northernmost part of the Clarksville Greenway meanders along a creek through a route canopied with large trees. The greenway helps establish a buffer along the Red River and nearby streams while providing a habitat for diverse plant and animal species. There is a bike-share station at the Pollard Road Trailhead if trail users need to rent a bike for the ride.

After crossing the Red River, the trail here also becomes known as the [Cumberland Riverwalk](#). For the next 1.5

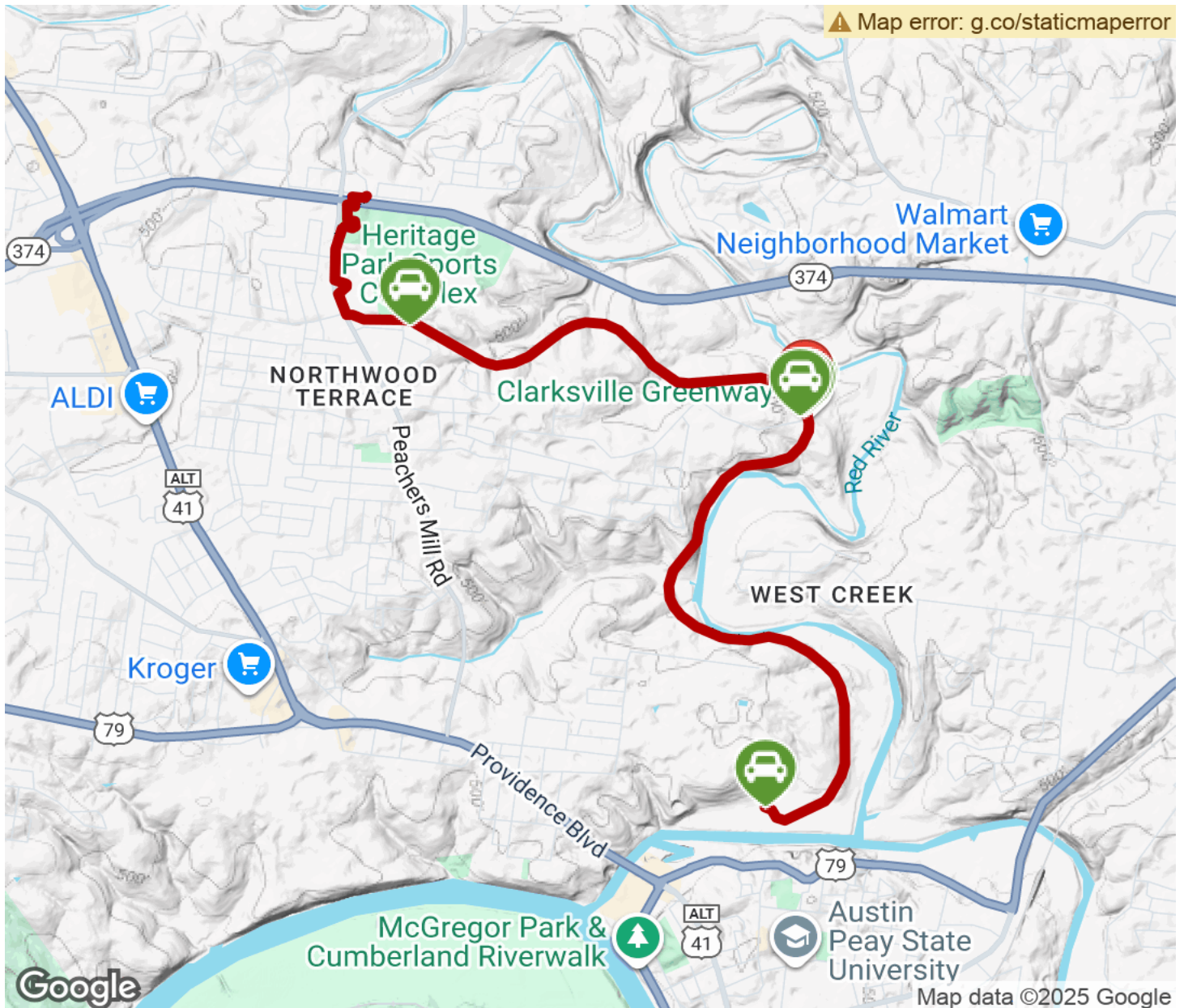
