There is no official parking for the trail but if you want to walk or bike between any of the shopping areas, you can park at the shopping centers along the route.



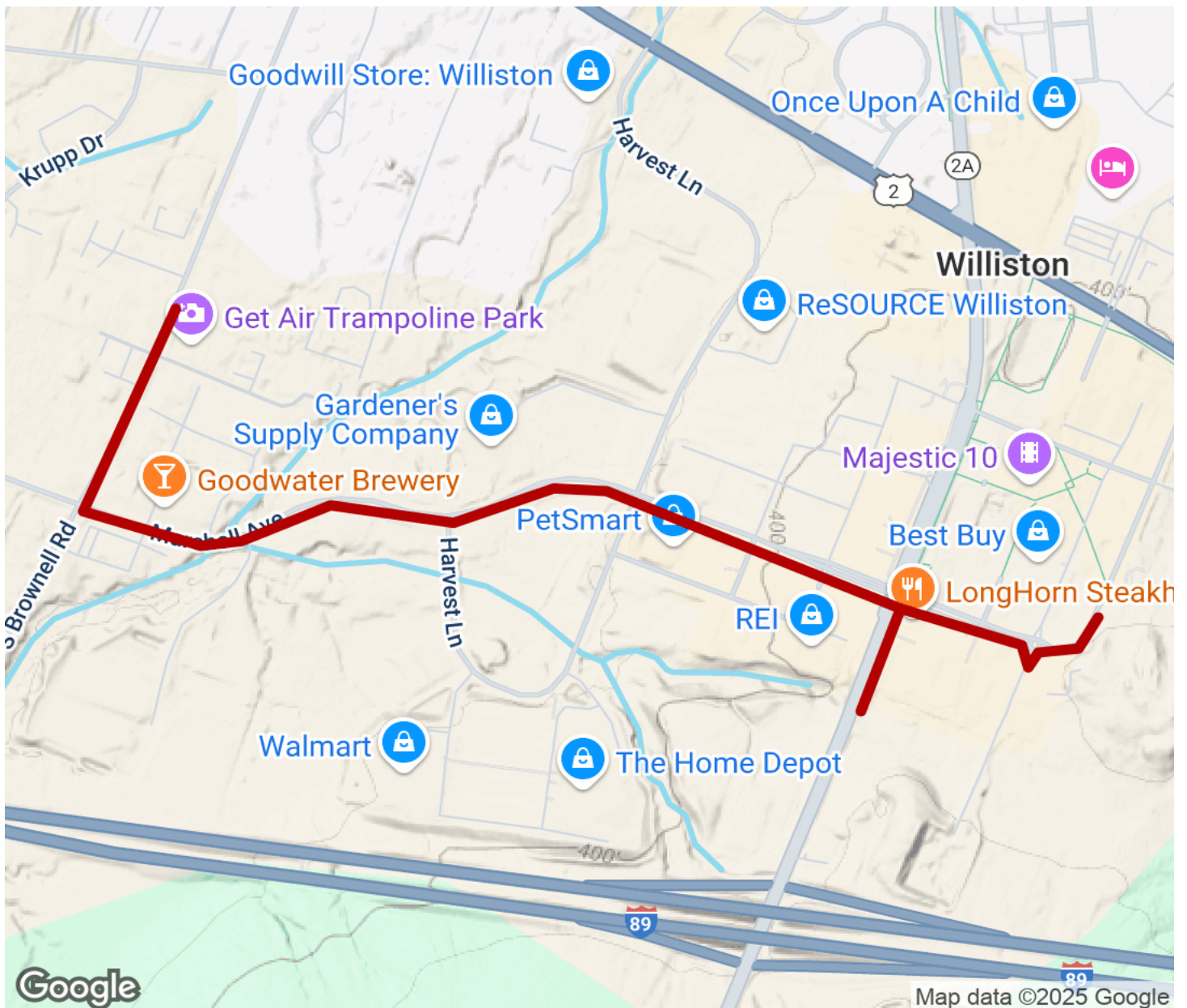
