The Means Woods Trail is a segment of the Trail Around Middlebury (TAM) and runs between Seminary Street Extension



The Means Woods Trail is a segment of the Trail Around Middlebury (TAM) and runs between Seminary Street Extension into Means Woods and the Aurora School off Peterson Terrace, east of the downtown Middlebury. Heading south from Seminary Street Extension, you can cross the road and enter Battell Woods, picking up the [Battell Woods Trail](#) network, also part of TAM.

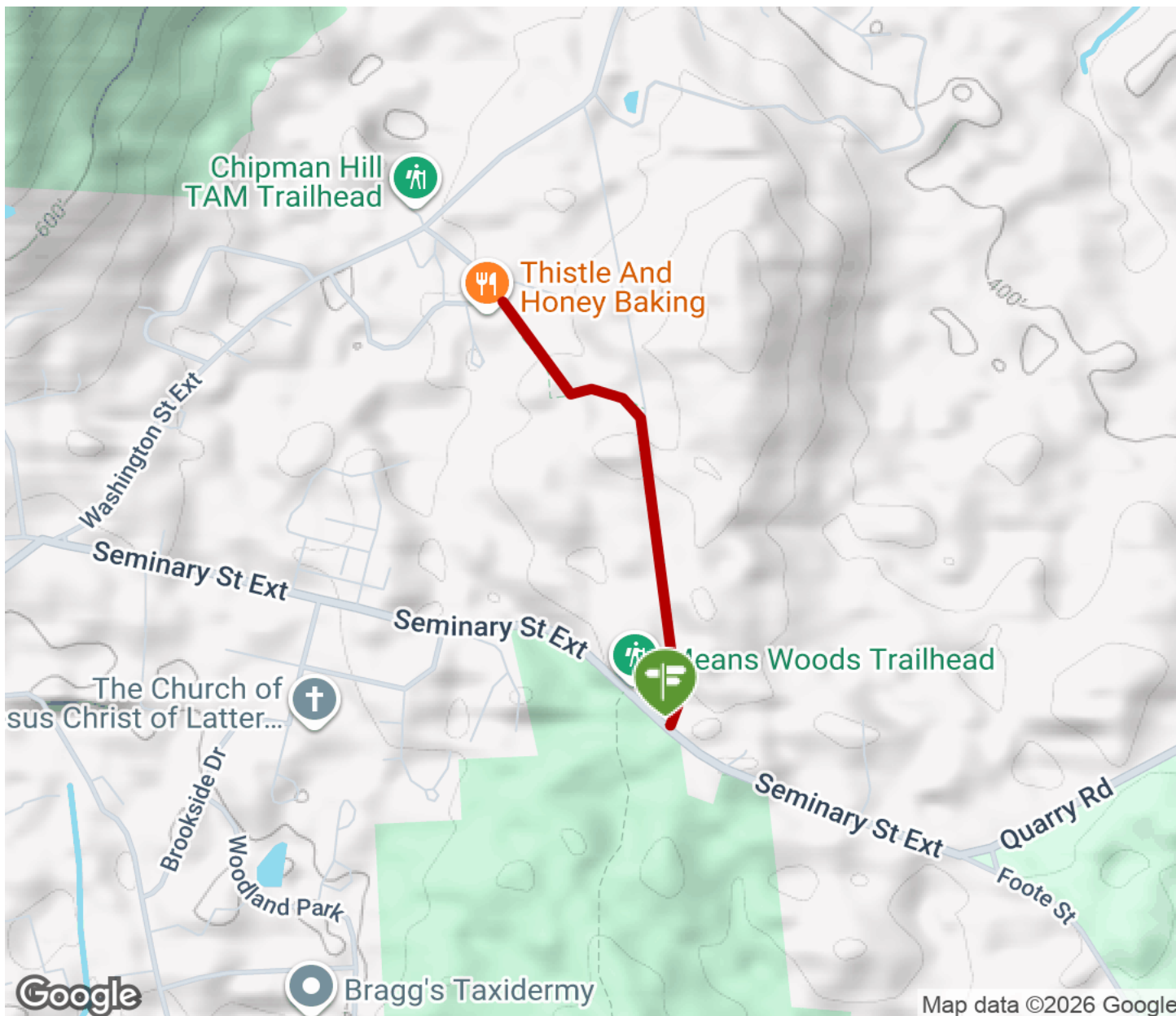
